CAG OF INDIA SIGNS MoU WITH THE GENERAL COURT OF AUDIT KINGDOM OF SAUDI ARABIA

The Comptroller and Auditor General of India (CAG) signed Memorandum of Understanding (MoUs) with the General Court of Audit, Kingdom of Saudi Arabia (SAI Saudi Arabia) during a bilateral meeting with the President of SAI Saudi Arabia yesterday in Riyadh, Saudi Arabia.



The MoU was signed with the aim of strengthening cooperation and exchange of expertise between the two nations in the field of public sector auditing. The area of cooperation encompasses conducting joint training programs on the topics related to financial, performance, and compliance audits and exchange of audit manuals and audit methodologies.

Mr. Girish Chandra Murmu, the CAG of India observed, “our commitment to a strong bilateral relationship is a witness to the shared values and objectives of our institutions and will serve to reinforce the bonds between our SAIs and our nations”. The CAG of India stated that the support and cooperation between the two SAIs will energize their capacity development initiatives and encourage exchange of knowledge and information between the two SAIs.
