Subject : Grant of dearness relief with effect from 01-01-2019 and 01-07-2019 on pension/family pension to the retired Judicial Officers of Government of Madhya Pradesh.

In continuation to this office circular No. Pen. Co-ordn./M P/Vol.-VII/DR&IR-Judi/76 dated 19-08-2019, this is to state that the Government of Madhya Pradesh in their Order Nos. 3(A)19/2003/21-B(1)/1608 dated 20-03-2019 and 5592/21-B(1)/2019 dated 26-10-2019 has sanctioned dearness relief on basic pension/family pension including additional pension/family pension at par with the Central Government for their retired Judicial Officers at the rates and from the dates mentioned below :

<i>Date of Effect</i>	<i>Rate of Dearness Relief per month</i>
01-01-2019	154% of basic pension/family pension
01-07-2019	164% of basic pension/family pension

2. (a) Besides, Government of Madhya Pradesh in their Notification No. 2212/2018/21-B(F) dated 05/18-05-2018 has sanctioned Interim Relief @ 30% on the basic pension/family pension to all categories/ranks of retired Judicial Officers of Government of Madhya Pradesh with effect from 01-01-2016.

(b) The said increase shall be treated as a separate component and no dearness relief shall be payable thereon.

(c) Arrears shall be worked out on the above basis and paid to the said pensioners/family pensioners with effect from 01-01-2016 along with arrears.

3. Having been authorised by Accountant General (A&E) - II, Madhya Pradesh in their letter Nos. Pension/4954 dated 11-03-2020, Pension/97 dated 15-05-2020 and Pension/3503 dated 26-11-2019, it is requested to make necessary arrangement for payment of dearness relief @ 154% and 164% on basic pension/family pension to the retired Judicial Officers of Government of Madhya Pradesh with effect from 01-01-2019 and 01-07-2019 respectively after proper adjustment.
