Subject : Grant of dearness relief with effect from 01-07-2021 on pension/family pension of the retired Judicial Officers of Government of Madhya Pradesh.

In continuation to this office circular No. Pen. Co-ordn./M P/Vol.-VII/DR-Judi/61 dated 17-09-2020, this is to state that the Government of Madhya Pradesh in their Order Nos. 3121/21-B(1)/2021 dated 17-08-2021 has sanctioned dearness relief on basic pension/family pension including additional pension/family pension at par with the Central Government for their retired Judicial Officers at the rate and from the date mentioned below :

01-07-2021	189% of basic pension/family pension

2. Having been authorized by the Accountant General (A&E) - II, Madhya Pradesh in their letter No. Pension/1435 dated 17-09-2021, it is requested to make necessary arrangement for payment of dearness relief @ 189% on basic pension/family pension of the retired Judicial Officers of Government of Madhya Pradesh with effect from 01-07-2021 after proper adjustment.
