Subject: Relaxation in Recruitment Rules for appointment to the posts of Auditor.

Sir/Madam,

As per Column 11 of the Schedule of Indian Audit & Accounts Department, Auditor Recruitment Rules 1988 further amended by GSR No. 84 dated 24.02.2000, method of recruitment to the post of Auditor is 50% by promotion failing which by direct recruitment and 50% by direct recruitment. Further, as per column 12 of aforesaid RRs, eligibility criteria for promotion to the post of Auditor are as under:

- (a) 40% of posts by promotion of Clerks with 5 years regular service in the grade on seniority basis subject to rejection of unfit.
- (b) 10 percent of posts by promotion from the following officials;
 - (i) Clerks on passing of Part-I of Section Officer's Grade Examination;
 - (ii) Graduate Clerks with three years regular service in the grade on passing of the Departmental Examination for Auditors; and
 - (iii) Graduate Group 'D' officials with three years regular service in the grade on passing of the Departmental Examination for Auditors.

2. Accordingly, to fill up the vacancies in Auditor cadre, the Comptroller & Auditor General of India, in exercise of powers contained in Rule 5 of the Indian Audit & Accounts Department (Auditors) Recruitment Rules, 1988, has ordered, in relaxation to column 11 and 12 of the schedule to the aforesaid rules, as under:

(i) Column 11: Method of recruitment:

50% by promotion failing which by deputation and 50% by direct recruitment.

(ii) Column 12: Eligibility criteria for promotion:

- a. 25% by promotion of Clerks with 5 years regular service in the grade on seniority basis subject to rejection of unfit; and
- b. 25% by promotion from following officials;
 - i. by promoting SAS Group I passed Group 'C' officials;
 - ii. Graduate Group 'C' officials with combined regular service of 3 years who have passed Departmental Examination for Auditors.

3. The aforesaid relaxation in Column 11 and 12 shall continue from the date of issue of this order till the amendment of Recruitment Rules to the post of Auditor.
