CBC will use these submissions as case studies for capacity building of present and future civil servants, and to assist in developing a Knowledge Repository that can be accessed by all to scale-up successful innovations in the country. Select innovations will also feature as part of the Annual Health of Civil Services Report to be submitted to the Prime Minister's Public Human Resource Council (PMHRC).

Applications will be accepted from 4th February 2022 till 5th March 2022. At the end of the submission period, innovations meeting the evaluation framework fulfilling the criteria will be shortlisted and invited to present their work to the CBC for final selection.
