Subject : Grant of dearness relief with effect from 01-07-2021 to the pensioners/family pensioners coming under the category of Kerala State Judicial Officer.


In continuation to this office circular No. Pen. Co-ordn./Kerala/Vol.VIII/DR-Judi/194 dated 12-03-2020, it is reminded that as per standing order of the Government of Kerala issued under GO Ms. No. 55/2011/Home dated 24-02-2011 (circulated under this office No. Pen. Co-ordn./Kerala/Vol.VII/DR&PTCont./226 dated 03-02-2012) pensioners/family pensioners coming under the category of Kerala State Judicial Officers are entitled to get revised rate of dearness relief as sanctioned by the Government of India from time to time for their pensioners/family pensioners, i.e. presently @ 189% on pension/family pension with effect from 01-07-2021 as per Government of India, Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure OM No. 1/3(1)/2008-E.II(B) dated 13-08-2021.

2. Having been authorized by the office of the Accountant General (A&E), Kerala in their authority No. PM/2/9-7/21-22/147/846 dated 25-08-2021, it is requested to make necessary arrangement for payment of dearness relief @ 189% with effect from 01-07-2021 to the pensioners/family pensioners coming under the category of Kerala State Judicial Officers after proper adjustment.
