HQ office has intimated that the SAS/RA/CPD I,II & III Examination-1 of 2022 would now be conducted from 17th May to 23rd May 2022. The cut off date for determining the eligibility for SAS/RA/CPD Examination-1 is 1st March 2022. The eligibility criteria for the above examinations are as shown below.

SAS (Civil & Commercial)

- 1. Two years continuous service in Group B or C post in this office who have passed SAS (Prelims) exam and has completed their probation period on or before 01.03.2022.
- 2. Under the modified system, the total chances to pass the SAS Examination will be twelve (6 normal + 6 additional).
- 3. The time limit for passing the SAS Examination will be eight years considering two Examinations in a year (8 years for 12 chances). The six additional chances are not consecutive as earlier.
- 4. The additional six chances will be admissible only to those candidates who have cleared five papers within first (normal) six attempts (6+6=12)
- 5. The eligible officials will be allowed to appear afresh in the SAS Examination after exhausting either twelve chances or eight years whichever is earlier from the first registration of CBT without any carry forward of exempted papers.
- 6. The eligible officials who could not pass five papers within the first (normal) six chances will also be allowed to appear afresh in the SAS Examination without any carry forward of exempted papers (no need to wait for completion of eight years)
- 7. Afresh means that the candidates are required to be screened through the Preliminary test, Mandatory training etc. as applicable to candidates appearing for the first time.
- 8. Those who have already exhausted ten chances will be allowed two more chances and have to avail these two chances within two years i.e., four Examinations (counting from Examination-1 of 2021).

- 9. In the modified system also, chance will be counted once a candidate registers for the SAS Examination.
- 10. No scope for withdrawal of candidature under the modified system.
- 11. In respect of direct recruit AAOs, they have to qualify the SAS Examination in respective branches during the period of probation for confirmation and regular appointment as AAO.

Revenue Audit Examination

- 1. Sr.AOs/AAOs having one year of continuous service in the Revenue Audit Branch as AAO/Sr.AO or after having prescribed training in Revenue Audit.
- 2. Confirmed directly recruited AAOs are eligible to appear in Revenue Audit Examination after completion of one year of regular service in Revenue Audit Branch as a regular AAO or have the prescribed training in Revenue Audit after completion of one year of regular service after confirmation as AAO.
- 3. HQ office vide Circular No.3 of 2021, dated 13.04.2021 had permitted two additional chances as a one-time opportunity to only the existing candidates of RA examination who have exhausted all permissible six chances but could not clear the examination by 13.04.2021 i.e., before the date of issue of HQ Circular. These two additional chances should be availed in four Examinations w.e.f. Examination-I of 2021 during two years (2021 & 2022).

Continuous Professional Development Examination (CPD)

- 1. Sr.AOs/AAOs who have completed four years continuous service in the grade are eligible to appear for CPD-I test. (AAOs promoted on or before 1st March 2018).
- 2. Sr.AOs/AAOs are eligible to appear for CPD-II test after elapse of four years from qualifying their first CPD test. (Officers who passed CPD I exam on or before September 2017).
- 3. Sr.AOs/AAOs are eligible to appear for CPD-III test after elapse of three years from qualifying their second CPD test. (Officers who passed CPD II exam on or before December 2018).
- 4. HQ office vide Circular No.3 of 2021, dated 13.04.2021 had permitted two additional chances as a one-time opportunity to only the existing candidates of CPD I & II examinations who have exhausted all permissible six chances but could not clear the examination by 13.04.2021 i.e., before the date of issue of HQ Circular. These two additional chances should be availed in four Examinations w.e.f. Examination-I of 2021 during two years (2021 & 2022).

Eligible candidates who intend to appear for the SAS/RA/CPD-I,II&III Examination-1 of 2022 may submit their application (in enclosed format) by e mail (admin.ker1.au@cag.gov.in) positively by 23.03.2022.
