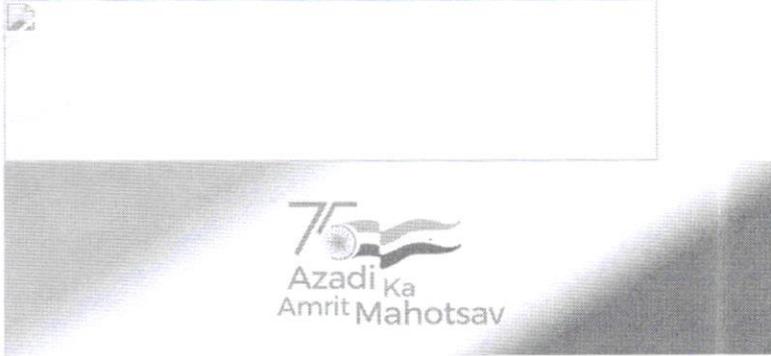
6. The officers who are nominated for the training program have to comprehend the contents of the training and should be able to impart training for the benefit of their colleagues.
