Proceedings of the Departmental Screening Committee constituted for appointment on compassionate ground in Group 'C' cadre for the year 2022 in the Office of the Principal Accountant General (A&E)-I, Maharashtra.

The Departmental Screening Committee comprising of Ms. Supriya Singh, Director, O/o the Director General of Audit (Navy), Mumbai, Ms. Anu Jose, Sr. Deputy Accountant General/ Admn, O/o The Principal Accountant General (Audit-I), Mumbai and Sh. Madhusoodanan K. Nair, Sr. Deputy Accountant General/AMG-V, O/o The Accountant General (Audit)-II, Branch Mumbai met on 14.09.2022 to consider the cases for compassionate appointment in Group C cadre in the Office of the Principal Accountant General (A&E)-I, Maharashtra, Mumbai. As the Financial enquiry report did not contain adequate information, the Committee requested to furnish more information and details by deputing an officer to visit their premises. The Committee was informed that further details were collected by the Senior Accounts Officer and submitted the same to the Administration. Based on this, the Committee met again on 07-10-2022 to consider those two cases of compassionate appointment. The Committee referred the consolidated instructions in the form of master circular on scheme of compassionate appointment which have been issued vide DoPT OM F.No. 14014/1/2022-Estt.(D) dated 02-08-2022 while considering the cases for compassionate appointment.

2. Accordingly, appointment on compassionate grounds should be made upto a maximum 5% of vacancies falling under direct recruitment quota in any Group 'C' posts. Fraction of a vacancy either half or exceeding half but less than one may be taken as one vacancy in terms of GOI DoPT OM dated 28-12-1999.

3. The Committee was informed about the vacancy position in Group 'C' cadre as follows:

4. The Committee was informed about the minimum educational qualification in Group 'C' cadre as follows:

Sr.No.	Name of Post	Educational qualification
1	Accountant	Bachelor's degree of a recognized University
2	DEO Gr. 'A'	12 th in Science stream with Mathematics as a subject from a recognized Board or University & speed test not less than 15000 key depressions per hour for data entry work. Qualification is relaxable at the discretion of the Staff Selection Commission or competent authority for reasons to be recorded in writing, in case of candidate otherwise well qualified.

3	Accounts Clerk	12 th pass or equivalent from a recognized Board or University Typing speed for 35 words per minute in English or 30 words per minute in Hindi on computer correspond to 10500 key depressions per hour or 9000 key depressions per hour respectively on an average of 5 key depressions (for each word)
4	Multi Tasking Staff(MTS)	Matriculation or equivalent passed from recognized School/Board.

5. The Committee was informed that the members have to satisfy themselves, before recommending the dependent family member for compassionate appointment that the family is indigent and deserves immediate assistance for relief from financial destitution, and applicant for compassionate appointment is eligible for the same under the Scheme. For the panel year 2022, a total 05 vacancies in Group 'C' have been earmarked for compassionate appointment under Direct Recruitment quota. As per Master Circular dated 02-08-2022, compassionate appointment can be made to the Group 'C' posts against the direct recruitment quota.

6. The Committee analyzed records produced by the administration such as relevant and applicable rules, statement of general financial status of the candidates, the reports of Senior Accounts Officer/(I/c) Welfare and other relevant documents to evaluate the suitability of the candidate for the available post. Marks as per revised evaluation system awarded to candidate indicated have been taken into cognizance.

7. The Committee was informed that the age limit for direct recruitment is between 18 and 27 years.

8. The Committee after going through personal files of deceased employees, evaluation sheets, reports of the Senior Accounts Officer/(I/c) Welfare and other relevant records, recommends the following :

1. In the case of Shri. Prajwal Sadanand Bijjargi, aged 18 years, son of late Sadanand A. Bijjargi Senior Accounts Officer, Committee feels that the family is not financially indigent and is also not in immediate need of financial support. As per the latest report of the Senior Accounts Officer deputed by the Office of the Principal Accountant General (A&E)-I, Maharashtra, Mumbai to assess the physical and financial condition of the families, the family is in possession of a flat worth Rs. 60 lakh (approximately) and has a monthly income of Rs. 1,08,200/- . The widow is an earning member. After considering all the above factors, marks scored (50 out of 165) in the evaluation and overall situation of the family, the Committee considers Shri Prajwal Sadanand Bijjargi '**NOT FIT**' for appointment on compassionate grounds.
2. In the case of Smt. Daksha S. Kharat aged 39 years, wife of late Satish V. Kharat, Sr. Accountant, the Committee feels that the family is passing through financial distress.



There is no earning member in the family. Smt. Daksha S. Kharat has the responsibility of upbringing and educating her daughter who is aged 18 years and son who is nine years old. Therefore, considering the overall economic and financial circumstances, marks obtained (95 including 15 Bonus Points) in the evaluation, report of the Senior Accounts Officer and other relevant documents, the Committee feels that appointment on compassionate grounds would help the family in coping with the financial crisis. Smt. Daksha S. Kharat is a graduate. The Committee, therefore, in order to enhance the economic condition and provide means of livelihood to the family of late Satish V. Kharat, recommends the relaxation of upper age limit in terms of Para 6B(a) of DoPT OM dated 02-08-2022 and considers Smt. Daksha S. Kharat 'FIT' for appointment on compassionate grounds to the post of Clerk.

It is certified that none of the candidates being considered for compassionate appointment is related to any of the members of the Screening Committee and that the Screening Committee members are otherwise also not interested in the candidates being considered for the compassionate appointment.
