Sub: Revised Syllabus of Subordinate Audit/Accounts Services (SAS) Examination

Madam/Sir,

The Comptroller and Auditor General of India constituted a committee headed by ADAI (Staff) to review the Subordinate Audit/Accounts Services (SAS) Examination syllabus, papers and the pattern of Questions. The Competent Authority has accepted the recommendations of the committee so constituted and has approved the revised syllabus along with paper wise exemption matrix of SAS Exam.

- 2. The salient features of the revised syllabus and pattern of SAS Examination, are as follows:
  - a) The number of branches of exams have been rationalised from 7 to 6 branches combining Civil Audit and Local Audit.
  - b) The number of papers (PCs), have been rationalised from 27 to 20 papers.
  - c) A candidate has to pass 8 papers in 2 groups of 4 papers each.
  - d) 3 out of 4 papers in Group-I, are common to all branches [PC-1: Language Skills, PC-2: Government Audit & PC-3: Information Technology (Theory & Practical)].
- 3. The revised syllabus of SAS Examination shall be implemented from Examination-II of 2024.
- 4. The revised syllabus along with paper wise exemption matrix is attached herewith for information. The same may be viewed/downloaded from CAG's website (cag.gov.in>Departmental Examinations>Syllabus & Books).
