Subject: Grant of dearness relief to the Andhra Pradesh Government pensioners/family pensioners with effect from 01-07-2021.

In continuation to this office circular No. Pen. Co-ordn./Andhra Pradesh/Vol.-VI/DR/170 dated 24-02-2022, this is to state that the Government of Andhra Pradesh in their G.O. Ms. No. 09 dated 17-01-2022 has revised the rate of dearness relief sanctioned in their G.O.(P) No. 100 dated 21-12-2021 and circulated by this office vide aforesaid circular dated 24-02-2022 from 38.776% to 55.544% with effect from 01-07-2021 in respect of:-

those who retired from service after 01-07-2013 and drawing pay in the Revised

Pay Scales, 2015; and

those who retired prior to 01-07-2013 and whose pension was consolidated in the light of orders issued in the G.O.(P) No. 51 dated 08-05-2015 and circulated by this office circular No. Pen. Co-ordn./Andhra Pradesh/Vol.-VI/Revision/136 dated 09-12-2015.

2. Government of Andhra Pradesh has also revised the rate of dearness relief from 164% to 189% with effect from 01-07-2021 in respect of pensioners who retired while drawing UGC I'ay Scales 2006 from 01-01-2006.

3. Government of Andhra Pradesh has also revised the rate of dearness relief from 164% to 189% with effect from 01-07-2021 in respect of pensioners who drawing pension as

per Justice E. Padmanabhan Committee report.

4. Government of Andhra Pradesh has further revised the rate of dearness relief from 17% to 31% with effect from 01-07-2021 in respect of pensioners who retired while drawing UGC Pay Scales 2016 from 01-01-2016.

5. These orders are applicable to:

- a) All Government pensioners in receipt of Service Pensions, Family Pensions under Revised Pension Rules, 1951, Andhra Pradesh Liberalised Pension Rules, 1961 and Andhra Pradesh Government Servants (Family Pension) Rules, 1964.
- b) Teaching and non-teaching pensioners of Municipalities, Panchayat Raj Institutions and Aided Educational Institutions who are in receipt of pensions under the Andhra Pradesh Liberalised Pension Rules 1961 and Andhra Pradesh Govt. Servants (Family Pension) Rules 1964.
- c) Teaching and non-teaching staff in Aided Educational Institutions in receipt of pensions under the Contributory Provident Fund-cum-Pension and Gratuity Rules 1961 and Andhra Pradesh Liberalised Pension Rules 1961.
- d) Those drawing family pensions under the G O Ms. No. 22 dated 16-01-1971, G O Ms. No. 104 dated 13-04-1973 and G O Ms. No. 25 dated 02-02-1974.
- e) Pensioners who are in receipt of Compassionate Pension under the rules for Compassionate Pensions and Gratuities in the Hyderabad Civil Services Rules.
- f) Those in receipt of pensions under the Wound and Extraordinary Pension Rules.
- g) Pensioners governed by Andhra Pradesh Revised Pension Rules, 1980.
- 6. These orders are not applicable to the financial assistance grantees and others who are not getting dearness relief.
  - 7. The amount of dearness relief shall be rounded off to next higher rupee.

- 8. Having been authorised by the Accountant General (A&E), Andhra Pradesh in their authority Nos. PAG(A&E)/AP/PM-I/OGP/2022-23/316061 (SSA No. 16119) dated 08-04-2022 and PAG (A&E)/AP/PM-I/OGP/2022-23/322544 dated 14-10-2022, it is requested to make necessary arrangement for payment of dearness relief to all eligible Andhra Pradesh Government pensioners/family pensioners with effect from 01-07-2021 at the rate mentioned herein after proper adjustment.
