**Subject : (i) Grant of dearness relief to the Telangana Government pensioners/  
family pensioners with effect from 01-07-2021; and  
(ii) Grant of additional quantum of pension/family pension notionally with  
effect from 01-07-2018 and monetary benefits from 01-04-2020  
to the retired University/Government/Aided Retired teachers,  
who are drawing UGC/AICTE Pay Scales in the State and all  
Non-Government Service Pensioners.**

In continuation to this office circular No. Pen. Co-ordn./Telangana/Vol.-II/DR/103 dated 16-09-2022, this is to state that the Government of Telangana in their GO Ms.No. 10 dated 23-01-2023 has revised the rate of dearness relief sanctioned in the Government of Telangana GO Ms. No. 4 dated 19-01-2022 and circulated by this office circular dated 16-09-2022 mentioned above from 17.29% to 20.02% with effect from 01-07-2021 in respect of :-

- i) those who retired from service on or after 01-07-2018 and drawing pension in the Revised Pay Scales 2020; and
- ii) those who retired prior to 01-07-2018 and whose pension was consolidated in the light of orders issued in the GO Ms. No. 55 dated 11-06-2021 mentioned above and communicated under circular No. Pen. Co-ordn./Telangana/Vol.-II/Revision/145 dated 12-01-2022.

2. Government of Telangana has also revised the rate of dearness relief from 51.876% to 55.536% with effect from 01-07-2021 in respect of pensioners who are drawing pension in the Revised Pay Scales 2015.

3. Government of Telangana has further revised the rate of dearness relief from 28% to 31% with effect from 01-07-2021 in respect of pensioners who retired while drawing UGC/AICTE/SNJPC Pay Scales 2016.

4. Government of Telangana has also revised the rate of dearness relief from 189% to 196% with effect from 01-07-2021 in respect of pensioners who retired while drawing UGC/AICTE/FNJPC Pay Scales 2006 and whose pension was not consolidated as per UGC Pay Scales 2016.

5. These orders are applicable to :

- a) All Government pensioners in receipt of Service Pensions, Family Pensions under Revised Pension Rules 1951, Andhra Pradesh Liberalised Pension Rules 1961, Andhra Pradesh Government Servants (Family Pension) Rules 1964 and Revised Pension Rules 1980.
- b) Teaching and non-teaching pensioners of Municipalities, Panchayat Raj Institutions and Aided Educational Institutions who are in receipt of pensions under the Andhra Pradesh Liberalised Pension Rules 1961 and Andhra Pradesh Government Servants (Family Pension) Rules 1964.
- c) Teaching and non-teaching staff in Aided Educational Institutions in receipt of pensions under the Contributory Provident Fund-cum-Pension and Gratuity Rules 1961 and Andhra Pradesh Liberalised Pension Rules 1961.
- d) Those drawing family pensions under the GO Ms. No. 122 dated 22-05-2014, GO Ms. No. 70 dated 23-10-2020 and GO Ms. No. 55 dated 11-06-2021.
- e) Pensioners who are in receipt of Compassionate Pension under the rules for Compassionate Pensions and Gratuities in the Hyderabad Civil Services Rules.
- f) Those in receipt of pensions under the Wound and the Extraordinary Pension Rules.
- g) Jagir and Estate Pensioners.
- h) Pensioners governed by the Telangana Revised Pension Rules, 1980.

6. These orders are not applicable to the financial assistance grantees and others who are not entitled for dearness relief.

7. The amount of dearness relief shall be rounded off to the next rupee.

8. Besides, in continuation to the para 19 of this office circular No. Pen. Co-ordn./Telangana/Vol.-II/Revision/145 dated 12-01-2022, this is to state that the Government of Telangana in their GO Ms. No. 113 dated 20-10-2021 has extended the said additional quantum of pension/family pension to the retired University/Government/Aided retired teachers, who are drawing UGC/AICTE Pay Scales in the State of Telangna and all Non-Government Service pensioners.

9. Having been authorised by the Principal Accountant General (A&E), Telangana in their letter Nos. PM-OGP/VI/2022-23/TS-GO/Circular/SSA No. 1251/340636 dated 24-02-2023 and PM-OGP/VI/2022-23/TS-GO's/Circular/SSA No. 1194/331906 dated 07-09-2022, it is requested to make necessary arrangement for payment of dearness relief to all eligible Telangana Government pensioners/family pensioners at the rate and from the date mentioned herein after proper adjustment. It is also requested to make necessary arrangement for payment of additional quantum of pension/family pension to the pensioners mentioned at para 8 above in the light of para 19 of aforesaid circular dated 12-01-2022.

10. The charges on this accounts are debitable to the head "8793-I.S.S. A/cs.; Government of Telangana etc."
