Office Order

Strengthening Vigilance Administration in the Supreme Audit Institution of India

The Comptroller and Auditor General of India has directed strengthening the Vigilance Wing as detailed below:

1. Establishment of a distinct Vigilance vertical entrusted with comprehensive responsibilities towards vigilance functions as described in the CVC manual, in respect of all officers and staff of the Institution, and functioning under the overall guidance and supervision of DAI (HR).
2. In accordance with Section 21 of the Comptroller and Auditor General's (Duties, Powers and Conditions of Service), 1971, the CAG will appoint a Director General/ Principal Director (Vigilance) heading the Vigilance vertical, performing the functions of Chief Vigilance Officer (CVO) and responsible for
 - a. Preventive vigilance;
 - b. Punitive vigilance; and
 - c. Surveillance and detection.

The vigilance functions at present being performed by the PD (Personnel) wing are transferred to the Vigilance vertical headed by the DG/ PD (Vigilance).

3. Punitive function of the Vigilance vertical entails preparing the case and recommending disciplinary action to the respective cadre controlling authorities; who will then take appropriate action after following the procedure prescribed in the CCS(CCA) Rules.
4. The DG/PD (Vigilance) will be supported at Headquarters by a complement of Sr.AOs/ AAOs operating on a desk officer basis.

5. Positions at Group Officer level, designated as Director / Deputy Director (Vigilance) and reporting to the DG/ PD (Vigilance) will be created at the regional level, responsible for vigilance functions in respect of non-gazetted staff of offices of the region. The regional dispensations will be operationalised in a phased manner.
6. The regional Director / Deputy Director (Vigilance) will be supported by personnel preferably from offices which are not within the jurisdiction of the regional officer; sourced on deputation basis.
7. Consultation at appropriate stages as prescribed in the vigilance manual, will now be made with the vigilance vertical.
8. DG / PD (Vigilance) at Headquarters will have vigilance jurisdiction over all IA&AS officers (upto the grade of PAG/DG) and all gazetted staff of the entire organisation. For officers above the grade of PAG/DG the vigilance jurisdiction would be exercised by the DAI(HR).
