Subject: Grant of dearness relief to the Karnataka Government pensioners/family pensioners with effect from 01-07-2024 (monetary benefits from 01-08-2024).

Date: 20-02-2025

In continuation to this office circular No. Pen. Co-ordn./Karnataka/Vol.-VI/Revision/104 dated 10-10-2024, this is to state that the Government of Karnataka in their Order No. FD 43 SRP 2024 dated 27-11-2024 has enhanced the dearness relief from the existing rate of 8.50% to 10.75% with effect from 01-07-2024 on revised basic pension/family pension (under 2024 Revised Pay Scale and Revised Pension) to their pensioners/family pensioners including the pensioners/family pensioners of the Aided Educational Institutions whose pension/family pension is paid out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Karnataka.

- 2. Besides, in continuation to this office circular No. Pen. Co-ordn./Karnataka/Vol.-VI/DR/31 dated 03-05-2024, this is to state that the Government of Karnataka in their Order No. FD 43 SRP 2024 (I) dated 28-11-2024 has enhanced the dearness relief from the existing rate of 42.50% to 45.25% with effect from 01-07-2024 on basic pension/family pension to their pensioners/family pensioners including the pensioners/family pensioners of the Aided Educational Institutions whose pension/family pension is paid out of the Consolidated Fund of the State of Karnataka, whose pension/family pension have not been revised as per circular dated 10-10-2024 ibid and who are drawing pension/family pension (under 2018 Revised Pay Scales) vide this office circular No. Pen. Co-ordn./Karnataka/Vol.-VI/Revision/78 dated 30-07-2018.
- 3. The monetary benefits of the aforesaid revised rates of dearness relief are admissible with effect from 01-08-2024.
- 4. Payment of dearness relief involving fraction of 50 paise and above shall be rounded off to the next rupee and fraction less than 50 paise shall be ignored.
- 5. This order shall also be applicable to the retired employees who were on UGC/AICTE/ICAR Scales of pay.
- 6. This order shall not be applicable to NJPC pensioners. Separate orders will be issued in respect of those pensioners.
- 7. Having been authorised by the Accountant General (A&E), Karnataka in their letter No. PM/G III/2023-24/DA/SS-/624 dated 28-01-2025, it is requested to make necessary arrangement for payment of dearness relief @ 10.75% on revised pension/family pension and @ 45.25% on un-revised pension/family pension with effect from 01-08-2024 to the Karnataka Government pensioners/family pensioners mentioned above after proper adjustment.
