About the Centre

The South Central Zone Cultural Centre (SCZCC), Nagpur is the youngest of the seven Zonal Cultural Centres established in India. It was set up in 1986 under the Ministry of Culture, Government of India, with its headquarters at Nagpur. The Centre covers the culturally diverse and linguistically varied states of Maharashtra, Telangana, Andhra Pradesh, Karnataka, Madhya Pradesh, and Chhattisgarh.

Each of these states boasts rich traditions of folk, tribal, and fine arts and crafts. The Centre is dedicated to **promoting**, **preserving**, **and enriching these traditions** through a variety of cultural activities. One of its core objectives is the **preservation of fading and vanishing art forms**, which are often threatened by modern societal changes, shifting values, and economic pressures.

The Centre takes proactive steps to **revive and sustain endangered arts and crafts**, employing innovations such as audio-visual documentation and research-based programming. It operates with a strong commitment to the **promotion**, **projection**, and **dissemination of India's cultural heritage**.

To ensure efficient and effective functioning, the Centre is guided by a robust institutional framework comprising a **Governing Body, Executive Board, Finance Committee**, and **Programme Committee**. These include:

- The Hon'ble Governor of Maharashtra as Chairman
- The Union Minister for Culture
- Culture Ministers and Secretaries from participating states
- Chairpersons of Central and State Cultural Academies
- Eminent individuals from the fields of art and culture

These bodies provide policy direction, approve programmes, and sanction budgetary allocations.

Since its inception, SCZCC has successfully organized numerous cultural programmes that **celebrate the spirit of rural and tribal India**, and encourage participation from across its zonal states. The Centre also identifies and rejuvenates disappearing traditional art forms through a dedicated **Zonal Level Advisory Committee** responsible for research and documentation. As of now, five vanishing art forms have been fully documented, with two more under process.

A major milestone for the Centre was the establishment of **Shilpgram at Khajuraho in 1997**, which has become a prominent cultural site. The Centre offers infrastructure and logistic support including an **Art Gallery**, **Documentation Cell, and Open Air Theatre**, providing platforms for artists to exhibit and perform their work.

Ethnic huts representing the cultures of Karnataka, Madhya Pradesh, and Chhattisgarh have also been constructed on the campus, enhancing its aesthetic and cultural ambiance. These initiatives have made SCZCC a vibrant cultural hub that attracts art lovers and tourists alike.

Further, the Centre has appointed **nodal officers in each of the six states** to help decentralize operations and **expand outreach**. These efforts are aimed at ensuring that the diverse art forms of the region continue to **flourish under the Centre's patronage**.

Through all its activities, the SCZCC continues to nurture and celebrate **both** ancient and contemporary artistic traditions, ensuring that the cultural nectar of India is preserved and passed on to future generations.


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
