Subject : Grant of dearness relief to the Uttar Pradesh Government civil pensioners/family pensioners with effect from 01-01-2026.

In continuation to this office circular No. Pen. Co-ordn./UP/Vol.-VII/DR/106 dated 08-12-2025, this is to state that the Government of Uttar Pradesh in their OM No. 3/2026/G-3-256/10-2026/301/2000T.C. dated 21-05-2026 has sanctioned dearness relief to their pensioners/family pensioners on their revised pension/family pension at the rate and from the date as under :

<i>Date of effect</i>	<i>Rate of dearness relief per month</i>
01-01-2026	60% of basic pension/family pension

2. In the calculation of dearness relief, fraction of a rupee less than its half shall be ignored while half or more shall be counted as one rupee.

3. These orders will also be applicable to pensioners of institutions aided from State Fund, under the Education/Technical Education Departments, whose pension/family pension is at par with that of the pensioners of the Government of Uttar Pradesh.

4. These orders will not be applicable to the Judges of High Court of Uttar Pradesh, employees of local bodies and public undertakings/corporations etc. in respect of whom separate orders will be issued by respective departments.

5. Having been authorized by the Accountant General (A&E)-II, Uttar Pradesh in their authority No. Pension Miscellaneous/25883-26145 dated 30-06-2026, received through e-mail dated 30-06-2026, it is requested to make necessary arrangement for payment of dearness relief to all eligible Uttar Pradesh Government pensioners/family pensioners @ 60% with effect from 01-01-2026 on their basic pension/family pension after proper adjustment.

6. The charges on this account are debitable to the head "8793-I.S.S.A/cs.; Government of Uttar Pradesh etc."
