*Subject : Grant of Dearness Relief to the Jammu &
Kashmir Government pensioners/family
pensioners with effect from 01-01-2026.*

In continuation to this office circular No. Pen. Co-ordn./Jammu & Kashmir/Vol.- III/DR/132 dated 14-01-2026, this is to state that Government of Jammu & Kashmir in their Order No. 189-F of 2026 dated 15-05-2026 has sanctioned dearness relief to JK UT pensioners/family pensioners as under :

<i>Date of effect</i>	<i>Rate of dearness relief per month</i>
01-01-2026	60% of basic pension/family pension

2. The payment on account of dearness relief involving a fraction of a rupee shall be rounded off to the next higher rupee.

3. The other provisions governing grant of dearness relief on pension/family pension such as regulation of Dearness Allowance during employment/re-employment, where more than one pension is drawn etc. and other provisions of the existing orders/rules (as are not in conflict of the provisions of this order) shall continue to remain in force.

4. Having been authorised by the Principal Accountant General (A&E) Jammu & Kashmir in their authority No. Pen A/c/2026-27/DA/330-363 dated 03-06-2026, it is requested to make necessary arrangement for payment of dearness relief @ 60% on basic pension/family pension with effect from 01-01-2026 to all eligible Jammu & Kashmir UT pensioners/family pensioners keeping in view the instructions laid down above and after making proper adjustment.

5. The charges of this accounts are debitable to the head "8793-I.S.S. A/cs.; Government of Jammu & Kashmir etc."
