*Subject : Grant of Dearness Relief to the
Jammu & Kashmir Government
pensioners/family pensioners on their un-
revised pension/family pension with effect
from 01-07-2012 onwards.*

This is to state that this office had issued last circular under No. Pen. Co-ordn./Jammu & Kashmir/Vol.- III/DR/166 dated 30-10-2012 for payment of dearness relief @ 65% with effect from 01-01-2012 in respect of Jammu and Kashmir pensioners/family pensioners who are drawing pension/family pension as per 6th Pay Commission, i.e. whose pension/family pension has not been revised afterwards as per Government of Jammu and Kashmir FD Order No. 222-F of 2018 dated 24-04-2018, OM No. A/Misc (2008)-temp-1236 dated 14-06-2018 and endorsed Corrigendum No. A/37 (2017)-1255 dated 25-07-2018, circulated by this office under No. Pen. Co-ordn./Jammu & Kashmir/Vol.- III/Revision/90 dated 31-08-2022). After that the Government of Jammu and Kashmir has sanctioned dearness relief from time to time to their pensioners/family pensioners on their un-revised pension/family pension with effect from 01-07-2012 onwards, as conveyed by their Finance Department letter No. FD-Code/507/2025-12 dated 25-03-2026, as under :

Besides, Government of Jammu and Kashmir in their FD Order Nos. 215-F of 2024 dated 26-06-2024, 330-F of 2024 dated 16-10-2024, 88-F of 2025 dated 13-03-2025, 158-F of 2025 dated 04-06-2025, 275-F of 2025 dated 28-10-2025 and 191-F of 2026 dated 15-05-2026 has sanctioned dearness relief to their pensioners/family pensioners on their un-revised pension/family pension at the rate of 230% with effect from 01-07-2023, 239% with effect from 01-01-2024, 246% with effect from 01-07-2024, 252% with effect from 01-01-2025, 257% with effect from 01-07-2025 and 262% with effect from 01-01-2026 respectively.

3. Payment of dearness relief involving a fraction of a rupee shall be rounded to the next higher rupee.

4. Having been authorised by the Principal Accountant General (A&E) Jammu & Kashmir, Jammu vide their authority Nos. Pen A/c/2024-25/DA/1375-1407 dated 10-03-2025, Pen A/c/2025-26/DA/440-72 dated 15-07-2025, Pen A/cs/2025-26/DA/789-822 dated 24-11-2025, Pen A/c/2026-27/DA/330-363 dated 03-06-2026 and Pen A/c/DA/2026-27/50-51 dated 08-05-2026, it is requested to make necessary arrangement for payment of dearness relief to the Jammu and Kashmir Government pensioners/family pensioners on their un-revised pension/family pension at the rate and from the date mentioned above after proper adjustment.
