

PREFACE

This Stand Alone Report of the Comptroller and Auditor General of India containing the results of Performance Audit of Development and Promotion of Horticulture in Manipur for the year ended 31 March 2020 has been prepared for submission to the Governor of Manipur under Article 151 of the Constitution of India.

The Horticulture and Soil Conservation Department is responsible for horticulture development and soil and water conservation to promote growing and management of fruits, vegetables including tubers, ornamental, aromatic and medicinal crops, spices and to intervene and support plantation of crops and their processing including value addition and marketing.
