Preface

This Report of the Comptroller and Auditor General of India for the year ended 31 March 2021 has been prepared for submission to the Governor of the State of Goa under Article 151 of the Constitution of India. This Report contains two chapters *i.e.* Chapter I & Chapter II.

Chapter I of this Report relates to audit of expenditure of the Social, General and Economic Sectors of the Government departments. This Chapter contains significant results of the audit of the departments/autonomous bodies of the Government of Goa.
