The undersigned is directed to refer to Finance Department's O.M.No.FEG.8/2017/60 dated 23/10/2019 and to say that Governor of Assam is pleased to decide that the Dearness Allowance/Dearness Relief (DA/DR) to the State Government employees and the pensioners who are entitled to draw pay & pension as per A.S. (ROP) Rules. 2017 shall be admissible as per rate shown below:

Period from which payable Rate of D.A./D.R. enhanced 11% Rate of D.A./D.R per mensem 28% of Basic Pay/Basic Pension

Note: The payment on account of D.A./D.R. involving fractions of 50 paise and above may b_Q rounded off to the next higher rupee and fraction of less than 50 paise may be ignored.

- 1) The increase subsumes the additional instalments arising on 01-01-2020, 01-07-2020 and 01-01-2021. The rate of dearness Allowance for the period from 01-01-2020 till 30, 06-2021 shall remain at 17%.

- (ii) The arrear D.A/D.R. for the month of July. 2021 shall be paid in a single installment through Bank Accounts of the Employees/Pensioners.
- 6) The Treasuries and Sub-Treasuries in Assam/Authorized Public Sector Banks are requested to arrange for the payment of Dearness relief to the Pensioners/Family Pension Holders/Extra Ordinary Pension Holders on the basis of this O.M.
