

Grant of revised rate of Dearness Relief @ 31% to Central Government Pensioners / Family Pensioners etc. effective from 01/07/2021

In continuation to this office circular No. Pen.Co-ordn./55 Vol.VI/142 Vol.III/65 Vol.IV/ 66 Vol.III/44 dated 03/08/2021, it is stated that Government of India, Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances & Pensions, Department of Pension & Pensioners' Welfare under their O.M. No 42/07/2021-P&PW(D) e-7330 dated 27/10/2021 have sanctioned Dearness Relief at the rate of 31% with effect from 01/07/2021 in supersession of the existing rate of 28% effective from 01/07/2021 as mentioned in O.M. No F 42/07/2021-P&PW(D) dated 22/07/2021 to (i) Civilian Central Government pensioners / family pensioners in PSU/Autonomous Bodies (ii) The Armed Forces pensioners / family pensioners, Civilian pensioners / family pensioners paid out of the Defence Service Estimates, (iii) All India Service pensioners / family pensioners (iv) Railway pensioners / family pensioners (v) Pensioners who are in receipt of provisional pension (vi) The Burma Civilian pensioners / family pensioners / family pensioners / families of displaced Government pensioners from Pakistan.

- 2. This circular will not be applicable to
 - (a) CPF beneficiaries, their widows and eligible children who are in receipt of exgratia payment in terms of Department of Pension & Pensioners' Welfare OM No. 45/52/97-P&PW(E) dated 16/12/1997 and revised subsequently vide OM No. 1/10/2012-P&PW(E) dated 27/06/2013.
 - (b) Burma Military pensioners / family pensioners.



- 3. The retired officers of West Bengal Judicial Service and family pensioners of such category whose pension/family pension has been regulated /revised in terms of Judicial Department Memo No 7012 J and 7014 J both dated 25/10/2010 would not come within the ambit of this circular and a separate circular letter in respect of such category of pensioners / family pensioners will be issued separately on enhancement of such applicable rate.
- 4. In the case of retired Judges of the High Court, separate circular will be issued on receipt of necessary order from the Ministry of Law and Justice.
- 5. Amount of Dearness Relief involving a fraction of a rupee shall be rounded off to the next higher rupee.
- 6. It will be the responsibility of the pension disbursing authorities, including nationalized banks etc. to calculate the quantum of Dearness Relief payable in each individual case.
- 7. All concerned Pension Disbursing Officers are, therefore, requested to make necessary arrangement for payment of Dearness Relief @ 31% to the above eligible categories of pensioners/ family pensioners with effect from 01/07/2021, along with arrear of dearness relief following the above guideline, as applicable, after proper adjustment.
- 8. Charges for payment of above enhanced rate of dearness relief to the pensioners / family pensioners are debitable to the Government of India/Railway/Defence Accounts under the proper head of account as usual.
