उपर्युक्त विषय के सम्बन्ध में मुझे यह कहने का निदेश हुआ है कि राज्य सरकार के ऐसे पेंशनर, जिनकी पेंशन सातवें वेतनमान आयोग की संस्तुतियों के कम में पुनरीक्षित की गयी है को वित्त विभाग के कार्यालय ज्ञाप संख्या-220/XXVII(7)02/2016 दिनांक 24 सितम्बर, 2021 द्वारा स्वीकृत महंगाई राहत की दरों को अतिक्रमित करते हुए दिनांक 01-07-2021 से 28 प्रतिशत के स्थान पर 31 प्रतिशत की दर से महंगाई राहत अनुमन्य किये जाने की श्री राज्यपाल सहर्ष स्वीकृति प्रदान करते हैं।

The Undersigned is directed to say that the Governor is pleased to revise the Dearness Relief rates w.e.f. 01-07-2021 @ 31% instead of 28 % superseding the earlier rates as is sanctioned vide this Office Memorandum No. 220/XXVII(7)02/2016 Dated 24 September, 2021 for those pensioners whose pension is revised in accordance with the recommendation of the 7th pay Commissions.

ORDER

Sub: Grant of Dearness Relief to State Government Pensioners.

The Governor is pleased to order that the existing rate of Dearness Relief sanctioned vide Finance Department Order of even number dated 25-10-2021 to the State Government Pensioners who are in receipt of superannuation, retiring, invalid, compensation, family and extraordinary pension etc. shall be revised from 31% to 34% with effect from 01-01-2022.

For the purpose of this order -

- (i) Pension/Family Pension in the case of pre-01-01-2016 retirees and where Family Pension was sanctioned prior to 01-01-2016, means the Revised Pension or Revised Family Pension, as the case may be, effective from 01-01-2016 in terms of Finance Department Memorandum No. F.12(6)FD(Rules)/2017 dated 30-10-2017 as amended vide Order No. F.12(6)FD(Rules)/ 2017 dated 09-12-2017 and F.12(6)FD(Rules)/ 2017 Pt.-I dated 06-06-2018.
- (ii) In the case of pensioners who retire from service on or after 01-01-2017 or where family pension is sanctioned for the first time on or after 01-01-2017, Pension/Family Pension means the Basic Pension/Basic Family Pension, as the case may be, in terms of Finance Department Notification No. F.12(6)FD(Rules)/ 2017 dated 30-10-2017 as amended vide Order No. F.12(6)FD(Rules)/ 2017 dated 09-12-2017.
- (iii) Dearness Relief will also be admissible on the additional quantum of pension / family pension allowed to the pensioners who have attained the age of 80 years and above.
- (iv) Payment of Dearness Relief involving a fraction of a rupee shall be rounded off to the next higher rupee.
- (v) Other provisions governing grant of dearness relief to pensioners' such as regulation of dearness relief during employment/re-employment, regulation of dearness relief where more than one pension is drawn etc., will remain unchanged.
- (vi) This order shall also be applicable in case of Pensioners/Family Pensioners who are in receipt of provisional pension.

- (vii) This order shall not be applicable in case of Old Age Pensions, Political Pensions or any other kind of similar pensions, which are not related to the service rendered under Government.
- (viii) Dearness Relief at revised rates as above would also be admissible to pensioners who retired/retire from service of Panchayat Samiti or Zila Parishad and whose Pension Payment Orders have been issued by the Director, Local Fund Audit Department or Director, Pension and Pensioners' Welfare Department, Rajasthan, Jaipur.
- (ix) Cash payment shall be admissible from 01-01-2022.

ORDER:

Government have issued comprehensive orders on implementation of 11th PRC Revised Pay Scales, 2022 vide G.O. 1st read above. Payment of arrears have been ordered at para 19 of the same.

2. The Committee constituted by the Government vide G.O. 2nd read above, after deliberations with Employees' Associations, recommended that there would not be any recovery of Interim Relief paid during 01.07.2019 and 31.03.2020 from the pension of service pensioner / family pensioner.

3. Government after careful consideration of the entire matter and keeping in view of the welfare of the retired employees / pensioners, have decided to dispense with recovery of Interim Relief paid for the period from 01.07.2019 to 31.03.2020.

4. Accordingly, Government hereby orders to revise the para 19 of the G.O.in the reference 1st read above and orders as follows:

4.1 Arrears on account of consolidation of pension/family pension shall be calculated duly preparing a due-drawn statement from April 2020 to December 2021 and shall be paid along with DR arrears for the period from July 2019 to December 2021 after adjusting the total interim relief paid from April 2020 to December 2021. The Interim Relief paid from 01.07.2019 to 31.03.2020 shall not be recovered.

4.2 The arrears payable after adjusting the interim relief shall be paid in four equal quarterly instalments starting from 1st January, 2023.

4.3 If any pensioner/family pensioner has drawn more Interim Relief than the revised consolidated pension and DR arrears combined, the same shall be adjusted from his/her future DR Arrears.

5. These orders shall come into force w.e.f. 01.01.2022.

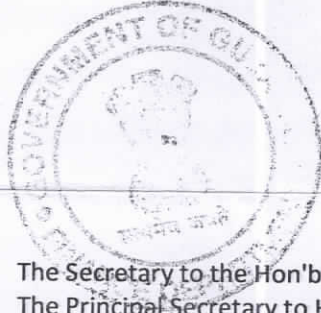
The State Government has decided to pay 28% temporary increase (Dearness Relief) to State Government Pensioners / Family Pensioners vide GR mentioned at (IV) above. Government has now decided to increase the rates of Temporary Increase (Dearness Relief) admissible to State Government Pensioners/ Family Pensioners with effect from Dt.01/07/2021 as under.


No.	Admissible from date	Admissible Rate
1.	From 01/07/2021	31% of the basic pay

1. Payment of Temporary Increase (Dearness Relief) involving a fraction of a rupee shall be rounded off to the nearest rupee (lower or higher).
2. Temporary Increase (Dearness Relief) at the rates indicated in above table will also be admissible on the additional basic pension/additional family pension available to Pensioners/Family Pensioners based on their age as indicated in Government Resolution, Finance Department, No.PGR-102016-6-Pay Cell, dated 15th October, 2016 and Government Resolution, Finance Department No. PGR-102016-7-Pay Cell, dated 15th October 2016.
3. The temporary increase as 31% will be paid regularly along with monthly pension from May-2022, the difference of 10 months from July-2021 to April-2022 of the proposed temporary increase will be paid in two installments: (1) first installment (July-2021 to November-2021) along with the pension of May-2022 and (2) second installment (December-2021 to April-2022) along with the pension of June-2022.

4. It will be the responsibility of the Pension Disbursing Authority, to calculate the quantum of Dearness Relief payable in each individual case.
5. All Accountant General of the respective States/Central Administrative Authority except Gujarat State are requested to take necessary action to authorize all the disbursing authorities under their control for making payment to Gujarat Pensioners drawing pension from their State Treasuries, Including Public Sector Banks.
6. Other Provisions governing grant of temporary Increase (Dearness Relief) to Pensioners such as regulations of dearness relief during employment/re-employment, regulations to temporary increase (Dearness Relief), where more than one pension is drawn etc. will remain unchanged.





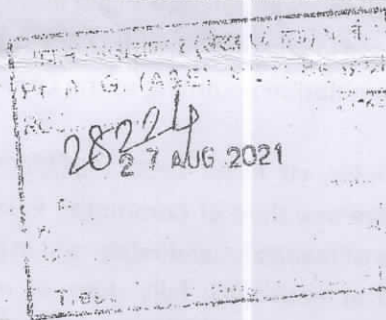

No 42/07/2022-P&PW(D) dated 05/04/2022 have sanctioned Dearness Relief at the rate of 34% with effect from 01/01/2022 in supersession of the rate mentioned in O.M. No 42/07/2021-P&PW(D) e-7330 dated 27/10/2021 to (i) Civilian Central Government pensioners/family pensioners including absorbee pensioners in PSU/Autonomous Bodies (ii) The Armed Forces Pensioners, Civilian Pensioners paid out of the Defence Service Estimates, (iii) All India Service Pensioners / family pensioners (iv) Railway Pensioners / family pensioners (v) Pensioners who are in receipt of provisional pension (vi) The Burma Civilian Pensioners / Family Pensioners and (vii) Pensioners/families of displaced Government pensioners from Pakistan.

7. All concerned Pension Disbursing Officers are, therefore, requested to make necessary arrangement for payment of Dearness Relief @ 34% to the above eligible categories of pensioners/ family pensioners with effect from 01/01/2022, along with arrear of dearness relief following the above guideline, as applicable, after proper adjustment.
8. Charges for payment of above enhanced rate of dearness relief to the pensioners / family pensioners are debitable to the Government of India/Railway/Defence Accounts under the proper head of account as usual.

It is informed that the Government of West Bengal, Finance (Audit) Department, in their Memo No. 1573-F(P₂) dated 18-4-2022 (copy enclosed) have sanctioned Ex-gratia Grant of ₹ 2,700/- (Rupees Two thousand Seven hundred only) **in lump per head** to all their pensioners including the holders of provisional pension who retired prior to **30-09-2021** and also the pensioners who retired/died or will retire/die **after 30-09-2021** but prior to **01-09-2022** and are not eligible to receive ad-hoc bonus.

2. The Ex-gratia grant sanctioned in the aforesaid Memo will also be admissible to the pensioners/family pensioners mentioned in Para 3 of the enclosed Memo.

The classes of pensioner who will not come within the purview of the Memo have also been clearly indicated in Para 4 & 5 of the Memo *ibid*.

In this connection, it is informed that the **pro-rata pension holders** are also entitled to get the benefit of full amount of ex-gratia grant, sanctioned in the above Memo. in terms of Govt. of West Bengal, Finance Department, Pension Branch's clarificatory letter No. 805-F(Pen), dated 10-12-2008 (circulated by this Office circular No Pen. Co-ordn/7 Vol. III/64 Vol. II/191 dated 07-01-2009), subject to fulfillment of the conditions as laid down in the Memo.

3. The ex-gratia grant sanctioned in the Memo. will, however, be admissible only to pensioners/family pensioners whose basic pension/family pension along with dearness relief does not exceed ₹ 32,000/- as on 31-03-2022.

4. Necessary arrangements for payment of Ex-gratia @ ₹ 2,700/- (Rupees Two thousand Seven hundred only) to the eligible West Bengal Govt. pensioners/family pensioners may please be made, keeping in view the instructions contained in the enclosed Memo. as well as in this circular.

5. The payment of ex-gratia as sanctioned in the Memo. should be made to the Muslim Pensioners/Family Pensioners before the festival of Id-UI-Fitre and to other than Muslim Pensioners/Family Pensioners, the payment in this regard may be made **in between 19-09-2022 and 23-09-2022**.

MEMORANDUM

Subject: Grant of ex-gratia payment to the State Government Pensioners for the year 2021-2022.

The undersigned is directed by order of the Governor to say that in order to provide some relief to the State Government Pensioners during the ensuing festivals, the Governor has been pleased to decide that all State Government Pensioners including the holders of provisional pension who retired prior to 30.09.2021 and also the pensioners who retired or died after 30.09.2021 but prior to 01.09.2022 and whose basic pension plus Dearness Relief on pension as on 31st March, 2022 did not exceed Rs.32,000/- (Rupees Thirty two thousand) only and are not eligible for ad-hoc bonus shall be paid an ex-gratia of Rs.2,700/- (Rupees Two thousand Seven hundred) only in lump per head.

2. The charge is debit to the head "2071-Pension and other retirement Benefits-01-Civil-800-other Expenditure-NP-001-fund required for meeting other expenditure-V-04-Pension/Gratulties" during the current financial year.

3. The ex-gratia grant sanctioned herein will also be admissible to:-

- i) The holders of family pension, ex-gratia family pension and ad-hoc family pension;
- ii) Pensioners (including widow pension holders) who draw their pension sanctioned under French Pension Rules;
- iii) Holders of extra-ordinary pension; and
- iv) Holders of ex-gratia pension.

The benefit will also be admissible to the pensioners of the undivided Government of Bengal and the pensioners of the erstwhile East Pakistan (now Bangladesh) Government who migrated to West Bengal and are receiving pension under "Provisional Payment of Pension Scheme".

4. The Ex-gratia grant sanctioned herein will not be admissible to the special categories of pensioners, such as:-

- i) Pensioners who have migrated from Pakistan;
- ii) Political Pensioners;
- iii) Special Pensioners;
- iv) War Risk Pensioners;
- v) Pensioners governed by the All India Services Rules.

5. The benefit will not be admissible to those who are entitled to ad-hoc bonus sanctioned by the State Government and those who are employed/re-employed under any Public Undertakings/Statutory Bodies under the Government and are in receipt of bonus or ex-gratia payment in lieu thereof during the current financial year.

6. State Government pensioners who draw their pension through Public Sector Banks will get this ex-gratia grant through their respective Bank Account. The Principal Accountant General(A&E), West Bengal will issue an authority for this purpose to all such Banks under the Kolkata Payment Scheme immediately on receipt of this order so that the pensioners may draw the ex-gratia grant immediately to make their commitments for their festival. The Treasury Office will take appropriate steps for issue of cheque to the respective paying branches of the Banks and Post Offices, so that the pensioners receiving pension through Banks and Money Order get the payment of ex-gratia immediately to meet their commitments for their festival. No authority of the Principal Accountant General(A&E), West Bengal will be required for this purpose.

7. Subject to Para 6 above, this order will also be applicable to those who are eligible to this ex-gratia grant but whose pension/family pension has not yet been sanctioned. In their cases and in the case of persons who are drawing provisional pension, this amount of ex-gratia will be drawn by the authority competent to draw provisional pension in the same manner as the amount of provisional pension is drawn by him. In their cases, the facts of payment of ex-gratia grant should be intimated to the Principal Accountant General(A&E), West Bengal at the time of forwarding their pension papers for final sanction of pension.

The benefit of ex-gratia grant of Rs.2,700/- per head as has been sanctioned in this memorandum for the State Government Pensioners will also be allowed to the teaching and non-teaching Pensioners of State Aided Non-Government Educational Institutions and Pensioners of Panchayats, the Pensioners of Municipal Corporations/Municipalities/Local Bodies and other Organisations for whom Pension is authorized either by the Accountant General, West Bengal or the DPPG, West Bengal. In such cases the respective Administrative Department may sanction the benefit of ex-gratia payment @ Rs.2,700/- per head this year to the pensioners concerned under their control without making any further reference to Pension Branch of this Department.

The payment of ex-gratia as sanctioned hereinabove should be made before the festival of Id-UI-Fitre of 2022 for the Muslim Pensioners/Family Pensioners and other than Muslim Pensioners/Family Pensioners the benefits should be disbursed in between 19.09.2022 to 23.09.2022.



Subject: Grant of Dearness Relief @ 3% to those West Bengal Govt. pensioners/ family pensioners whose pension has been revised consequent on implementation of WBS (ROPA), 2019 and @ 133% to the pensioners/family pensioners drawing pension at the pre-revised rate i.e. as per G.O. No. 200-F(Pen) dated 25/2/2009, both w.e.f. 01-01-2021.


In continuation to this office circulars No. Pen. Co-ordn/93 Vol. VI/159 and Pen. Co-ordn/93 Vol. VI/160 both dated 13/11/2018, it is stated that Govt. of West Bengal, Finance (Audit) Department, in their Memo no. 3490-F (P₂) dated 14/12/2020 read with corrigendum issued vide no. 3533-F (P₂) dated 16/12/2020 and memorandum issued vide No. 78-F(P₂) dated 8/1/2021 (all enclosed), have introduced dearness relief @ 3% payable to those of their pensioners/family pensioners on such revised basic pension/family pension, which are revised in terms of their Memo. No. 535-F (Pen) or 536-F (Pen) both dated 1/10/2019 and enhanced the rate of dearness relief from 125% to 133% who are drawing basic pension/family pension at the pre-revised rate i.e. in terms of their Memo. No. 200-F (Pen) or 201-F (Pen) both dated 25-2-2009, w.e.f. 01/01/2021 in supersession of the rates mentioned in the circulars dated 13/11/2018.

Payment of relief on pension/family pension involving a fraction of a rupee shall be rounded off to the next higher Rupee in each case.

All Pension Disbursing Officers are, therefore, requested to make necessary arrangements for payment of dearness relief at the rates as contained in the enclosed memo, dated 14/12/2020, 16/12/2020 and 8/1/2021 to all eligible West Bengal Govt. pensioners/family pensioners after proper adjustment.

In this context, it is reiterated that separate circulars will be issued with regard to grant of dearness relief on pension/family pension to the teaching and non-teaching pensioner/family pensioners of Non-Govt. Educational Institution and Non Govt. Colleges on receipt of specific orders from the respective Administrative Departments.

Accountants General of other States are requested to arrange extra copies of the said Govt. order at their end, if necessary, for circulation within their State.

MEMORANDUM

Subject: Grant of Dearness Allowance to State Government Employees and the employees of Government aided Educational Institutions, employees of Statutory Bodies, Government Undertakings, Panchayats including Panchayat Karmee, Municipal Corporations/ Municipalities, Local Bodies etc. and also Dearness Relief to the Pensioners/Family Pensioners

The question of grant of (i) Dearness Allowance in the revised pay structure implemented as per recommendations of the 6th Pay Commission in respect of Government employees, the teaching & non-teaching employees of Government aided Educational Institutions, employees of Statutory Bodies, Government Undertakings, Panchayats including Panchayat Karmee, Municipal Corporations, Municipalities, Local Bodies etc. and (ii) Dearness Relief on the pension/family pension since revised as per recommendation of the said Pay Commission has been under consideration of the Government for some time past.

2. After careful consideration, the Governor has been pleased to decide the following:

(i) The whole time State Government employees drawing basic pay upto Rs. 2,01,000/- shall draw Dearness Allowance @3% of basic pay w.e.f. 01.01.2021. The calculation of Dearness Allowances shall be made taking into account the revised basic pay and NPA, if any, but it shall not include any other type of pay.

(ii) The Dearness Allowance as sanctioned at (i) above in respect of State Government employees shall be admissible to the teaching and non-teaching employees of Government aided educational institutions, employees of Statutory Bodies, Government Undertakings, Panchayats including Panchayat Karmee, Municipal Corporations/Municipalities, Local Bodies etc. The respective Administrative Department may sanction the benefit of Dearness Allowance @3% of revised basic pay w.e.f. 01.01.2021 to the employees concerned drawing basic pay upto Rs. 2,01,000/- under their control without making any further reference to Group P2 of this Department.

(iii) (a) The State Government Pensioners/Family Pensioners shall draw Dearness Relief @ 3% of revised basic pension/revised family pension w.e.f. 01.01.2021 in supersession of the rates previously allowed on the pre-revised pension/family pension.

(b) It will be the responsibility of the Pension Sanctioning Authority to calculate the quantum of Dearness Relief on revised Pension/revised Family Pension payable to each individual case.

(c) For the purpose of payment of dearness relief sanctioned herein, the Principal Accountant General (A&E), West Bengal, will issue authority to the Public Sector Banks in Kolkata and the Accountant General of other States.

(d) The Treasury or Sub-treasury Officers in this State will give effect to this para of this order without the authority of the Accountant General (A&E), West Bengal.

(iv) The Dearness Relief as sanctioned at (iii)(a) above for the State Government Pensioners/Family Pensioners shall also be admissible to the Pensioners/Family Pensioners of State aided Non-Government Educational Institutions, Statutory Bodies/Government Undertakings Panchayats, Municipal Corporations/Municipalities, Local Bodies etc. who are in receipt of revised Pension/revised Family Pension as per recommendations of 6th Pay Commission. The respective Administrative Department may sanction the benefit of Dearness Relief @ 3% of revised Pension/revised Family Pension w.e.f. 01.01.2021 to the Pensioners/Family Pensioners concerned under their control without making any further reference to Pension Branch of the Department.

(v) The rate of Dearness Allowance in respect of the employees mentioned in para (1) above who are drawing pay in the pre-revised pay structure as per recommendation of the 5th Pay Commission shall be enhanced from 125% to 133% w.e.f. 01.01.2021.

(vi) The Dearness Allowance/Dearness Relief sanctioned herein shall be rounded off to the nearest rupee in each case.

(vii) In the case of Public Undertakings/Statutory Bodies, the additional expenditure for sanction of Dearness Allowance and Dearness Relief should be borne by such Undertakings/Bodies themselves out of their own resources or out of financial assistance provided to them in the budget and no additional financial assistance will be given to them on that account.

(viii) There will be a further ad-hoc increase in the Daily Rate of Wages by Rs. 17/- (Rupees Seventeen) only w.e.f. 01.01.2021 for the daily rated workers under the Government whose wages are not regulated by any Statutory provisions like the Minimum Wages Act, etc.
