

MEMORANDUM

Subject :-Grant of Interim Relief (Pay) to the Judicial Officers on the basis of recommendations in the Interim Report of the Second National Judicial Pay Commission.

The undersigned is directed to say that the consequent upon the decision taken by Second National Judicial Pay Commission relating to Interim Relief of pay for the Judicial Officers and this Government decision No. F.8(12)-GA(CAB)/2018 dated 19th May, 2018, the Governor is pleased to decide that the Interim Relief shall be admissible to the Judicial officers as well as retired Judicial Officers including pensioners/ family pensioners w.e.f. 01.01.2016 on the following terms and conditions :-

- a) Interim Relief to the extent of 30% of increase in Basic Pay with accrued increments shall be paid to all categories/ranks of Judicial Officers.
- b) The said increase in Pay shall be treated as a separate component and no D.A shall be payable thereon.
- c) Arrears shall be worked out with effect from 01-01-2016 on the above basis.
- d) On the same basis, the interim relief shall be provided to the pensioners and family pensioners with effect from 01-01-2016 and the arrears to be paid accordingly.
- e) The amounts payable by way of interim relief now proposed are liable to the adjusted against the future determination pursuant to the final report submitted by the Commission.

All Heads of Departments/Heads of Offices Concerned are, therefore, requested to arrange payment of DA as per the above enhanced rates of DA i.e from 139% to 142% w.e.f. 01-01-2018 to the employees of Central Government and Central Autonomous Bodies continuing to draw their pay in the pre-revised pay scale/grade pay as per 6th Central Pay Commission.

This enhanced rate of DA is applicable as DA/DR on their pre-revised Pay/Pension from the same date and on the same terms and conditions in respect of serving members of Tripura Judicial Service and those retired from Tripura Judicial Service also.

Subject: Rate of Dearness Allowance applicable w.e.f. 01.01.2018 to employees of Central Government and Central Autonomous Bodies continuing to draw their pay in the pre-revised pay scale/Grade Pay as per 6th Central Pay Commission

The undersigned is directed to refer to this Department's O.M. of even No. dated 26th September, 2017 regarding revision of the rate of Dearness Allowance w.e.f. 01.07.2017 in respect of employees of Central Government and Central Autonomous Bodies continuing to draw their pay in the pre-revised pay scale/Grade Pay as per 6th Central Pay Commission.

2. The rate of DA admissible to above categories of employees of Central Government and Central Autonomous Bodies shall be enhanced from the existing 139% to 142% w.e.f. 01.01.2018.

3. The provisions contained in paras 3, 4 and 5 of this Ministry's O.M.No.1(3)/2008-E.II(B) dated 29th August, 2008 shall continue to be applicable while regulating Dearness Allowance under these orders.

4. The contents of this Office Memorandum may also be brought to the notice of all organisations under the administrative control of the Ministries/Departments which have adopted the Central Government scales of pay.
