राज्य शासन, वित्त विभाग की अधिसूचना क्रमांक एफ ८-१/२०१६/ नियम/चार दिनांक २२ जुलाई २०१७ द्वारा शासकीय सेवकों के वेतन का पुनरीक्षण दिनांक ०१-०१-२०१६ से किया गया है।

२. राज्य शासन द्वारा निर्णय लिया गया है कि दिनांक ०१-०१-२०१६ को अथवा पश्चात सेवा निवृत्त/दिवंगत शासकीय सेवकों की पेंशन/ परिवार पेंशन हितलाभों का निम्नानुसार पुनरीक्षण किया जाए :-

- क. पेंशन, परिवार पेंशन, पेंशन सांराशिकरण, अवकाश नगदीकरण का निर्धारण मध्यप्रदेश सिविल सेवा (पेंशन) नियम, १९७६ के प्रावधानों के अनुसार पुनरीक्षित वेतनमान में [पूर्व में भुगतान राशि समायोजित करते हुए] किया जाए।
- ख. मध्यप्रदेश सिविल सेवा पेंशन नियम १९७६ के अंतर्गत देय मृत्यु-सह-सेवानिवृत्ति उपादान की अधिकतम सीमा रुपये २० लाख की जाती है।
- ग. पेंशन एवं परिवार पेंशन की न्यूनतम मासिक राशि रुपये ७७५०/- (बृद्धों को प्राप्त अतिरिक्त पेंशन को छोड़कर) की जाती है। पेंशन/ परिवार पेंशन की अधिकतम सीमा राज्य शासन के शासकीय सेवकों को पुनरीक्षित वेतनमान में प्राप्त अधिकतम वेतन का कमशः ५० एवं ३० प्रतिशत किया जाता है।


३. दिनांक ०१-०१-२०१६ से ३१-०८-२०१७ तक की अवधि के लिये पुनरीक्षित पेंशन/परिवार पेंशन की बढी हुई राशि का भुगतान पेंशन भुगतानकर्ता द्वारा पूर्व में किये गये भुगतान को समायोजित करते हुए किया जाएगा ।

4. पेंशन/परिवार पेंशन देय राशि की गणना में मंहगाई राहत की गणना निम्नानुसार होगी :-

वित्त विभाग के परिपत्र क्रमांक एफ-9-6/2017/नियम/चार दिनांक 04 जून 2018 के अनुसार राज्य शासन के पेंशनरों/परिवार पेंशनरों को दिनांक 01 जुलाई, 2017 से छटवें वेतनमान में मूल पेंशन/परिवार पेंशन पर 139 प्रतिशत की दर से एवं सातवें वेतनमान में 5 प्रतिशत की दर से मंहगाई राहत स्वीकृत है।

2/ राज्य शासन के पेंशनर/परिवार पेंशनरों को देय मंहगाई राहत की दरों में क्रमशः 01 जनवरी, 2018 एवं 01 जुलाई 2018 से निम्नानुसार वृद्धि करने पर राज्य शासन द्वारा सहर्ष स्वीकृति दी गई है :-

* राज्य शासन के आदेश अंतर्गत पेंशनर्स का सातवें वेतनमान में पेंशन पुनरीक्षण दिनांक 01 अप्रैल 2018 से प्रभावशील है। अतः 01 जनवरी 2018 से मार्च 2018 की अवधि के लिये छटवें वेतनमान एवं अप्रैल 2018 से सातवें वेतनमान अनुसार निर्धारित दर से मंहगाई राहत देय होगी।

80 वर्ष अथवा उससे अधिक आयु के पेंशनरों को देय अतिरिक्त पेंशन पर भी मंहगाई राहत देय होगी।

3/ उपरोक्त मंहगाई राहत, अधिवाषिकी (Superannuation), सेवा निवृत्त (Retiring), असमर्थता (Invalid), तथा क्षतिपूर्ति (Compensation) पेंशन पर देय होगी। सेवा से पदच्युत या सेवा से हटाये गये कर्मचारियों को स्वीकार किये गये अनुकम्पा भत्ता (Compassionate Allowance) पर भी इस मंहगाई राहत की पात्रता होगी तथा परिवार पेंशन तथा असाधारण पेंशन प्राप्त करने वाले पेंशनरो को भी उक्त मंहगाई राहत वित्त विभाग के ज्ञापन क्रमांक एफ.बी.6/43/76 /नियम-2 दिनांक 5-10-76 के प्रतिबंधो के अधीन देय होगी। यदि किसी व्यक्ति को उसके पति/पत्नि की मृत्यु के कारण अनुकम्पा के आधार पर सेवा में रखा गया है तो ऐसे मामलों में परिवार पेंशन पर मंहगाई राहत की पात्रता नहीं होगी परन्तु यदि पति/पत्नि की मृत्यु के समय वह सेवा में है तो पति/पत्नि की मृत्यु के कारण देय परिवार पेंशन पर उसे मंहगाई राहत की पात्रता होगी।

4/ ऐसे पेंशनर्स जिन्होंने अपनी पेंशन का एक भाग सारांशीकृत (Commute) कराया है, उन्हें मंहगाई राहत उनकी मूल पेंशन (सारांशीकरण के पूर्व की पेंशन) पर देय होगी।


5/ यह आदेश राज्य शासन के ऐसे सेवानिवृत्त कर्मचारियों को भी लागू होगा, जिन्होंने उपक्रमों /स्वशासी संस्थाओं/मण्डलों/निगमों आदि में संविलियन पर एक भुस्त राशि आहरित की है और जो वित्त विभाग के ज्ञाप क्रमांक एफ 9/9/2006/नियम/चार, दिनांक 5-1-2007 के अंतर्गत पेंशन के एक तिहाई हिस्से के प्रत्यावर्तन के पात्र हो गये हैं।

6/ मंहगाई राहत के भुगतान पर होने वाले रूपये के अपूर्ण भाग को अगले रूपये में पूर्णांकित किया जायेगा।

7/ राज्य शासन के समस्त पेंशन संवितरणकर्ता अधिकारियों को निर्देशित किया जाता है कि वित्त विभाग के पृ.क्र.ई-4/1-83/नि-5/चार, दिनांक 29 जनवरी,1983 तथा मध्यप्रदेश कोष संहिता भाग-1 के सहायक नियम 347 के संशोधित प्रावधानों को ध्यान में रखते हुए राज्य शासन के सिविल पेंशनरों को उपरोक्त अनुसार स्वीकृत राहत का शीघ्र भुगतान करे। संचालक पेंशन, बैंक की शाखाओं में नमूना जांच करे तथा विसंगति की स्थिति में उसका समायोजन आगामी माह के भुगतानों में कराया जाना सुनिश्चित करे।


I am directed to refer to this department's letter of even number dated 23rd October, 2018 on the above subject and to say that consequent upon grant of further Dearness Relief (DR) on pension/family pension to the employees of Central Government and Central Autonomous Bodies vide Department of Pension & Pensioners Welfare's O.M. No. 42/04/2019- P&PW(D) dated 6th March, 2019 (Copy enclosed), it has been decided that retired Judges of Supreme Court/High Courts and family pensioners of such Judges would be entitled to Dearness Relief on pension/family pension at the rate of 12% with effect from 1st January, 2019.

2. Payment of Dearness Relief involving a fraction of a rupee shall be rounded off to the next higher rupee.
3. The provision governing grant of Dearness Relief to pensioners such as regulation of dearness relief during employment/re-employment, regulation of dearness relief where more than one pension is drawn etc., will remain unchanged.
4. Other provisions contained in this Department's letter No. L-19016/3/97-Jus. dated 13th January, 1999 will remain unchanged.

5. Accountant Generals/Pay and Accounts Officers are requested to arrange payment of dearness relief to the pensioners on the basis of the aforesaid instructions as per the procedure adopted by the Department of Pension & Pensioners' Welfare without any further delay.

6. This issues with the concurrence of Integrated Finance Division vide their Dy. No. 3645/AS&FA dated 18.03.2019.



OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Sub: Grant of Dearness Relief to Central Government pensioners/family pensioners – Revised rate effective from 01.01.2019-reg

The undersigned is directed to refer to this Department's OM No. 42/06/2018-P&PW(G) dated 18.09.2018 on the subject mentioned above and to state that the President is pleased to decide that the Dearness Relief admissible to Central Government pensioners/family pensioners shall be enhanced from the existing rate of 9% to 12% w.e.f 01.01.2019.

2. These rates of DR will be applicable to (i) Civilian Central Government Pensioners/Family Pensioners including Central Govt. absorbee pensioners in PSU/Autonomous Bodies in respect of whom orders have been issued vide this Department's OM No. 4/34/2002-P&PW(D) Vol.II dated 23.06.2017 for restoration of full pension after expiry of commutation period of 15 years (ii) The Armed Forces Pensioners, Civilian Pensioners paid out of the Defence Service Estimates, (iii) All India Service Pensioners (iv) Railway Pensioners/family pensioners (v) Pensioners who are in receipt of provisional pension (vi) The Burma Civilian pensioners/family pensioners and pensioners/families of displaced Government Pensioners from Burma/Pakistan, in respect of whom orders have been issued vide this Department's OM No. 23/3/2008-P&PW(B) dated 11.09.2017.

3. The payment of Dearness Relief involving a fraction of a rupee shall be rounded off to the next higher rupee.

4. The payment of arrears of Dearness Relief shall not be made before the date of disbursement of pension/family pension of March, 2019.

5. Other provisions governing grant of DR in respect of employed family pensioners and re-employed Central Government Pensioners will be regulated in accordance with the provisions contained in this Department's OM No. 45/73/97-P&PW (G) dated 2.7.1999 as amended vide this Department's OM No. F.No. 38/88/2008-P&PW(G) dated 9th July, 2009. The provisions relating to regulation of DR where a pensioner is in receipt of more than one pension will remain unchanged.

6. In the case of retired Judges of the Supreme Court and High Courts, necessary orders will be issued by the Department of Justice separately.

7. It will be the responsibility of the pension disbursing authorities, including the nationalized banks, etc. to calculate the quantum of DR payable in each individual case.



8. The offices of Accountant General and authorised Pension Disbursing Banks are requested to arrange payment of relief to pensioners etc. on the basis of these instructions without waiting for any further instructions from the Comptroller and Auditor General of India and the Reserve Bank of India in view of letter No. 528-TA, II/34-80-II dated 23/04/1981 of the Comptroller and Auditor General of India addressed to all Accountant Generals and Reserve Bank of India Circular No. G.A.N.D. No. 2958/GA-64 (ii) (CGL)/81 dated the 21st May, 1981 addressed to State Bank of India and its subsidiaries and all Nationalised Banks.

9. In their application to the pensioners/family pensioners belonging to Indian Audit and Accounts Department, these orders issue after consultation with the C&AG.

10. This issues in accordance with Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure's OM No. 1/1/2019-E.II(B) dated 27th Feb, 2019.

Sub : Revision of Pension/Family Pension of Government Servants retired/deceased on or after 01.01.2016.

Through Notification no. F 8-1/2016/Rule/IV dated 22nd July, 2017 of the Finance Department of State Government, revision of pay of government servants has been done from 01.01.2016.

2. It has been decided by State Government that the pension/family pension benefits of Government Servants retired/deceased on or after 01.01.2016 may be revised as below :-

- a. The fixation of pension, family pension, pension commutation, leave encashment, shall be done in the revised pay scale (adjusting the amount of prior payment) as per the provisions of Madhya Pradesh Civil Service (Pension) Rules, 1976
- b. The maximum limit of Death-Cum-Retirement Gratuity payable under Madhya Pradesh Civil Service (Pension) Rules, 1976, is fixed as Rs.20 lakhs.
- c. Minimum monthly amount of pension and family pension is fixed as Rs.7750/- (except the additional pension received by the old aged). The maximum limit of pension/family pension is fixed as 50 and 30 percent respectively of the maximum pay received in the revised pay scale by the government servants of the State Government.
3. The payment of increased amount of revised pension/family pension for the period from 01.01.2016 to 31.08.2017 shall be done by the pension payer after adjusting the payments made earlier.
4. The calculation of dearness relief in the calculation of the amount payable as pension/family pension shall be as below :-

Sub :- Sanctioning of Dearness Relief on pension to the pensioners of Madhya Pradesh State.

As per circular no. F-9-6/2017//Rule/IV dated 04 June, 2018 of the Finance Department, dearness relief on basic pension/family pension at the rate of 139 percent in the Sixth Pay Scale and at the rate of 5 percent in the Seventh Pay Scale has been sanctioned to the pensioners/family pensioners of Madhya Pradesh State w.e.f. 01 July, 2017.

2. Sanction has been accorded by the State Government for increasing the rates of dearness relief payable to the pensioners/family pensioners of State Government from 01st January, 2018 and 01st July, 2018 as given below :-

* Under the orders of the State Government, revision of pension of pensioners in the Seventh Pay Scale is effective from 01st April 2018. Therefore, dearness relief shall be payable at the prescribed rates, in the Sixth Pay Scale for the period of 01st January, 2018 to 01st March, 2018 and in the Seventh Pay Scale from April 2018 onwards.

Dearness Relief shall also be payable on the additional pension payable to the pensioners above the age of 80 years.

3. Above dearness relief shall be payable on Superannuation, Retiring, Invalid and Compensation pension. Dearness Relief shall be eligible on the compassionate allowance admissible to the employees who have been removed or dismissed from service and the above dearness relief shall also be payable to the pensioners receiving family pension & extra ordinary pension subject to the conditions of memo no. FB/6/43/76/Rule-2/4 dated 05.10.76 of Department of Finance. If any person is appointed in service on compassionate grounds due to the death of his/her wife/husband, in

such cases dearness relief shall not be eligible on family pension. But if the person is in service at the time of death of his/her wife/husband, dearness relief will be eligible to him/her on the family pension payable on account of death of wife/husband.

4. Dearness relief shall be payable on the original pension (pension prior to commutation) of those pensioners, who have commuted a portion of their pension.

5. These orders shall also be applicable to those retired employees of the State Government, who have drawn a lump sum amount on absorption in Undertakings/Self Governing Institutions/ Divisions/Corporations etc. and who have become eligible for restoration of 1/3rd portion of pension under Memo no. 9/9/2006/Rule/IV dated 05.01.2007 of Dept of Finance.

6. Fraction of a rupee in the payment of dearness relief shall be rounded off to next higher rupee.

7. All Pension Disbursement Officers of the State Government are directed that in view of Endt No. E-4/1-83/R-5/IV, dated 29.01.1983 of Dept of Finance and the amended provisions of Subsidiary Rule 347 of Madhya Pradesh Treasury Code Part I, payment of relief sanctioned as above shall be made to the Civil Pensioners of the State Government at the earliest. The Director of Pension may conduct the test checking in the branches of banks and in case of any discrepancy, ensure its adjustment from the payments of ensuing month.
