**ORDER:**

Government hereby order the revision of rates of Dearness Relief to pensioners sanctioned in the G.O. 10<sup>th</sup> read above, raising it by 1.572% **from 24.104% of the basic pension to 25.676% of the basic pension from 01.07.2017** in respect of: -

- a. those who retired from service after 01.07.2013 and drawing pension in the Revised Pay Scales, 2015;
  - b. those who retired prior to 01.7.2013 and whose pension was consolidated in the light of orders issued in the G.O. 2<sup>nd</sup> read above.
2. Government also hereby order to revise the rates of Dearness Relief w.e.f. 01.07.2017 to various categories of pensioners as indicated below:
