As per the Office Memorandum read above, Government of India have enhanced the rate of Dearness Allowance payable to Central Government employees from the existing rate of 53% to 55% of the Basic Pay with effect from 1st January, 2025. Therefore, the rate of Dearness Allowance payable to the All India Service Officers (IAS, IPS and IFS) serving in connection with the affairs of the State Government, is ordered to be enhanced from the existing rate of 53% to 55% with effect from 1st January, 2025.

2. The arrears of Dearness Allowance consequent on this revision shall be paid in cash.
