**Sub:** Grant of Dearness Relief to the retired State Judicial Officers-revised rate effective from 1.1.2018-reg

**Ref:** 1. Office Memorandum No.1/3/2008-E.II(B) dated 28.03.2018 of Government of India, Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure  
2. GO (Ms) 55/2011/Home dated 24.2.2011

As per OM cited 1<sup>st</sup>, the Dearness Allowance payable to Central Government pensioners/ family pensioners Drawing pay in pre-revised scale came into force with effect from 1/07/2017 has been enhanced from the existing rate of 139% to **142%** with effect from **1/01/2018**.

Government of Kerala as per orders cited 2<sup>nd</sup> have extended the benefit of increase in Dearness Relief to central Government pensioners/ family pensioners to the retired state Judicial officers/nominee without waiting for further orders from the State Government.

Hence you are requested to honor the claim for enhanced Dearness relief at the rate of 142% w.e.f. 1/1/2018 preferred by pensioners/family pensioners coming under the category of State Judicial Officers in respect of whom pension has been revised on replacement scale came into force with effect from 1/01/2006.

Subject: **Rate of Dearness Allowance applicable w.e.f. 01.01.2018 to employees of Central Government and Central Autonomous Bodies continuing to draw their pay in the pre-revised pay scale/Grade Pay as per 6<sup>th</sup> Central Pay Commission**

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The undersigned is directed to refer to this Department's O.M. of even No. dated 26<sup>th</sup> September, 2017 regarding revision of the rate of Dearness Allowance w.e.f 01.07.2017 in respect of employees of Central Government and Central Autonomous Bodies continuing to draw their pay in the pre-revised pay scale/Grade Pay **as per 6<sup>th</sup> Central Pay Commission**.

2. The rate of DA admissible to above categories of employees of Central Government and Central Autonomous Bodies shall be enhanced from the existing 139% to **142% w.e.f. 01.01.2018**.
3. The provisions contained in paras 3, 4 and 5 of this Ministry's O.M.No.1(3)/2008-E.II(B) dated 29<sup>th</sup> August, 2008 shall continue to be applicable while regulating Dearness Allowance under these orders.
4. The contents of this Office Memorandum may also be brought to the notice of all organisations under the administrative control of the Ministries/Departments which have adopted the Central Government scales of pay.
