ORDER

As per the Office Memorandum read above, Government of India have enhanced the rate of Dearness Allowance payable to Central Government employees from the existing rate of 50% to 53% of the Basic Pay with effect from 1st July, 2024. Therefore, the rate of Dearness Allowance payable to the All India Service Officers (IAS, IPS and IFS) serving in connection with the affairs of the State Government, is ordered to be enhanced from the existing rate of 50% to 53% with effect from 1st July, 2024.

2. The arrears of Dearness Allowance consequent on this revision shall be paid in cash.
