Subject:- Enhancement of minimum pension/family pension of all Principals of Government Colleges, who retired prior to 1/1/2016

Sir,

In continuation to this office circular No.Pen.Co-ordn/300/14 dated 13/4/2011, it is stated that consequent upon revision of pay of the Principals of Govt. College (at ₹43,390/- plus grade pay ₹10000/) who have been directly recruited on or after 1.1.2006, the Govt. of West Bengal, Higher Education Science & Technology and Bio-Technology Department, Appointment Branch in their Memo No.805-Edn(A)/1P-02/15 dated 23/6/2017 have raised the minimum pension and family pension of the retired **pre-1.1.2006 Principals** of Govt. Colleges to ₹26,695/- p.m. and ₹16017/-p.m. respectively after partial modification of the Memo No.77-Edn(A) dated 2/2/2011.

2. The upper ceiling of pension and family pension will, however, remain unchanged, ie, ₹35000/- and ₹21000/- respectively as was fixed earlier by the Government, vide para 4.2. of Memo No. 196-Edn(A) dated 22/3/2010.

3. All Pension Disbursing Officers are, therefore, requested to review the amount of pension/family pension, being paid to the pre- 01/01/2006 pensioners/family pensioners in respect of Principals of Government colleges, and if it is found less than the minimum amount as stated in para 1 above, necessary steps may be taken to revise such pension/family pension accordingly with effect from 1.1.2006 under intimation to this office, after proper adjustment of pension/family pension already paid to them.
