Subject:- Payment of Dearness Allowances to the Judges of Supreme Court and High Courts.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to this Department's letter of even number dated 9th May, 2017 on the above subject and to say that Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure, vide O.M. No. 1/3/2008-E.II (B) dated 26th September, 2017(copy enclosed) has revised the rates of dearness Allowance (D.A.) payable to Central Government employees continuing to draw their pay in the pre-revised pay scale as per the 6th CPC w.e.f. 1st July, 2017. As per the revised rates the Central Government employees continuing to draw their pay in the pre-revised pay scale as per the 6th CPC are entitled to Dearness Allowance @ 139% (revised from 136% to 139%).

- 2. The revised rates of Dearness Allowance are also admissible to the Member of All India Services by virtue of the provisions contained in Rule 3 of the All India Service (D.A.) Rules, 1972.
 - 3. By virtue of the provisions contained in Rule 2 of High Court Judges Rules, 1956 and Rule 6 of the Supreme Court Judges Rules, 1959, the Judges of the High Courts and Supreme Court are also entitled to the revised rates of Dearness Allowance w.e.f. 01.07.2017 at the same rates (139%) as are admissible to the members of All India Service. The admissibility of Dearness Allowance would be subject to other conditions as stipulated by Department of expenditure's above mentioned O.M.
 - 4. This issues with the concurrence of Integrated Finance Division vide their Dy. No. 837/DS (Fin.) dated 17.10.2017.

Subject: Rate of Dearness Allowance applicable w.e.f. 01.07.2017 to employees of Central Government and Central Autonomous Bodies continuing to draw their pay in the pre-revised pay scale/Grade Pay as per 6th Central Pay Commission

The undersigned is directed to refer to this Department's O.M. of even No. dated 7th April, 2017 revising the rate of Dearness Allowance w.e.f. 01.01.2017 in respect of employees of Central Government and Central Autonomous Bodies continuing to draw their pay in the pre-revised pay scale/Grade Pay as per 6th Central Pay Commission.

- 2. The rate of DA admissible to above categories of employees of Central Government and Central Autonomous Bodies shall be enhanced from the existing 136% to 139% w.e.f. 01.07,2017.
- 3. The provisions contained in paras 3, 4 and 5 of this Ministry's O.M.No.1(3)/2008-E.II(B) dated 29th August, 2008 shall continue to be applicable while regulating Dearness Allowance under these orders.
- 4. The contents of this Office Memorandum may also be brought to the notice of all organisations under the administrative control of the Ministries/Departments which have adopted the Central Government scales of pay.
