**STUDENT INTERNSHIP PROGRAMME****Sub: Guidelines/Instructions for engagement of Student Interns**

The office of the C&AG of India announces the C&AG Internship Scheme. This Scheme seeks to engage students pursuing Undergraduate/Graduate/Post Graduate Degrees or are Research Scholars enrolled in recognized University / Institution within India or abroad, as Interns. These interns shall be given exposure to various functional wings in the office of C&AG. For the Interns the exposure to the functioning of the Indian Government and public sector auditing and accounting may be an add-on in furthering their future interests.

**2 Purpose:** To allow short term exposure of selected candidates with the different offices of the C&AG office located at Jaipur , as 'Interns'.

**3 Objectives of the Scheme:** The Scheme has the following stated objectives:

- a. To allow young academic talent to be associated with the C&AG's work for mutual benefit.
- b. The Interns shall have an opportunity to know about the Government functioning, public sector auditing and accounting and contribute to the Policy formulation by generating inputs such as empirical analysis, briefing reports, policy papers, etc.

**4 Logistics & Support:** Interns will be required to have their own laptops. They shall be provided working space, internet facility and other necessities as deemed fit by the concerned Heads.

**5 Procedure and conditions for Applicants:**

(i) Depending upon the number of applications received against a particular domain/ area, O/o the C&AG offices reserve the right to fix up the eligibility criteria, limit the number of applicants to be called for a particular period and to decide about the mode of screening thereof.

(ii) The selected applicant has to produce original mark sheets and NOC from the college/ institution at the time of joining, failing which his / her candidature shall be cancelled.

(iii) The selected candidates shall submit the soft copy of their NOC from their Head of the Department / Principal by giving sufficient time before issuance of the offer letter by the office. It also has to be indicated in the NOC that the student would not be registered for any course requiring his/ her attendance in the class during the period of internship. After obtaining the original NOC issued by the college/institution at the time of joining of the candidate and also verifying his / her eligibility from the original documents the joining will be given to the selected candidates. If any discrepancy is found, the candidature of the candidate will be cancelled.

(iv) Experience Certificate: A certificate regarding successful completion of Internship shall be issued by the Head of the Functional Wing in the enclosed format at Annexure (B)

**6 Attendance** - While doing internship in CAG, the candidate should have a minimum of 75% attendance, and they have to mark In and Out time on daily basis. In case of less than 75% attendance no extension of internship period is allowed and no experience certificate will be issued. The attendance record and the details of work supervision shall be maintained by the functional wings.

**7 The provisions of Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act, 2013, shall apply.**

**8 Return of Materials:** At the time of completion of engagement period, the intern must return to the O/o the C&AG of India all papers, drawings, notes, memoranda, manuals, specifications, designs, devices, documents, diskettes, CDs, DVDs. Tapes, and any other material on any media containing or disclosing any confidential or proprietary technical or business information. On completion of the engagement the intern shall also return any keys, pass cards, ID cards or other property belonging to the O/o the C&AG of India.

**9 Feedback:** Interns are mandated to give their feedback to the Head of the Functional Wing in O/o the CAG of India on their experience of the program.
