As per Headquarters Examination Wing circulars dated 25.05.2026 and 01.06.2026 the next proposed SAS/RA/I/CPD-I, II & III Examination-I of 2026 will be held from 22th June 2026 to 27st June 2026 as per date sheet enclosed in Annexure-1. Applications are invited from eligible candidates willing to appear in this Examination in the prescribed format for registration of the said examination latest by 08.06.2026.

मुख्यालय के परीक्षा विंग के दिनांक 25.05.2026 और 01.06.2026 के परिपत्र के अनुसार, अगली प्रस्तावित SAS/RA/I/CPD-I, II & III Examination-I of 2026, परीक्षा परिशिष्ट-1 में दर्शाए दिनांक शीट (Annexure-1) के अनुसार 22 जून 2026 से 27 जून 2026 तक आयोजित की जाएगी। अतः, इस परीक्षा में सम्मिलित होने के इच्छुक पात्र उम्मीदवारों से परीक्षा के लिए रजिस्ट्रेशन करने हेतु विहित प्रारूप में दिनांक 08/06/2026 आवेदन आमंत्रित किए जाते हैं।

The eligibility criteria for appearing in SAS/RA/I/CPD-I, II & III Examination-I of 2026 are mentioned below:

SAS Examination:

SAS Examination-I of 2026 will be conducted in new revised syllabus.

एसएस परीक्षा-I, 2026, नए संशोधित पाठ्यक्रम के अनुसार आयोजित की जाएगी।

Only persons who have put in minimum of 3 years continuous service in one or more of the following capacities in a particular field office of IA&AD and who had successfully completed their probation period are eligible to appear for the examination.

इस परीक्षा में केवल वे व्यक्ति पात्र होंगे जिन्होंने IA&AD के किसी विशेष फील्ड कार्यालय में निरंतर न्यूनतम 3 वर्ष की सेवा पूरी की हो तथा जिन्होंने अपनी परीक्षा अवधि (Probation Period) सफलतापूर्वक पूर्ण कर ली हो।

All eligible candidates have to appear in the respective papers as per exemption matrix in accordance with Headquarters circular dated

25/05/2026.

Incentive Examination:

Divisional Accounts Officer Grade-I who have put in one-year continuous service in the grade as on **01.03.2026** and all Sr. DAOs who did not appear in this examination or could not clear the said examination while working as DAO-I are also eligible to appear/reappear in this examination.

CPD-I:

All Sr. DAOs are eligible to appear in the CPD-I Examination-I of 2026, DAO-I would be eligible to appear in the examination only after completion of four years of continuous service as on 01.03.2026.


CPD-III:

All those candidates who have successfully completed 3 years of regular service as on 01.03.2026 after passing the CPD-II Examination are eligible for CPD-III Exam-I of 2026.



Madam/Sir,

The SAS/RA/I/CPD-I, II &III Exam-1 of 2026 as per the revised syllabus is proposed to be held in late June 2026. The date sheet of the examination will be intimated in due course. The cut-off date for eligibility for the examination is 1st March 2026.

The Revised syllabus contains 20 papers of six branches. In revised syllabus, a candidate is required to pass 08 papers in 02 Groups of four papers each. Also, an exemption matrix is incorporated in the revised syllabus which clearly indicates to candidates to pass the paper where no exemption exists. The new paper added i.e. PC-12, PC-13, PC-14, PC-15 & PC-16 have to be attempted by all the candidates of respective streams.

The papers will include case studies/application and assertion/reasoning based question having a graded difficulty level, in proportion to their weightage. The detailed syllabus and sample model questions have been uploaded on the official website of the CAG under the Examination tab.


Further, for SAS candidates who register for the first time (fresh candidates) the following condition will be applicable:

- i) The overall passing percentage in each paper will be 50%.
- ii) There will also be a sectional pass percentage of 40% in each paper.
- iii) The exemption threshold for each paper will be 60% with the currency of exemption limited to three years.

The final dates of SAS Exam-I of 2026, eligibility criteria etc. will be informed in due course.

2. Registration will be opened where vacancies are available in the respective cadres. Fresh candidates may be allowed to appear after giving an undertaking that they would only opt for CEA or CRA after passing the exam. The cut-off date for eligibility for the examination is 1st March 2026.


3. All HoDs are required to nominate a Group Officer as Examination Registration Officer (ERO) to manage and supervise the registration process. The basic data i.e. Name, DoB, Category etc. as mentioned in Service Books of the new candidates will be entered into the first part of the Registration Form by the ERO. Thereafter, the fresh candidates will complete the second part (exam details) of the Registration Form by themselves. The existing candidates will fill up the second part of the Registration Form after activation by the ERO. The ERO will verify and validate the data entered into the online registration forms to enable the HoD to approve their candidature. The onus of correctness of eligibility and data will be completely on the field offices. Chance of a candidate would be counted once she/he registers and there is no scope for withdrawal. The link for registration and user id & password of ERO & HoD for registration/validation/approval will be the same which was used in the previous SAS/RA/I/CPD-I,II&III-2 of 2025.

4. The officials who are on deputation to other offices within the department may submit their willingness/ application directly to their parent offices under intimation to Administration branch/section of the borrowing offices. Such candidates will make all examination related communication with their parent offices directly, for timely completion of registration process/other examination related issues.

5. The examination will be conducted in 28 test-centre cities. Candidates are permitted to appear only in their city of present posting or the city designated by the Exam Wing. Candidates appearing for the examination at city other than their station of posting may be treated as on tour on official duty and shall be entitled to TA/DA as admissible.

6. All communications with Exam Wing will be made at email id saoexam@cag.gov.in. Further, for speedy/timely communication, Sr. AOs/AOs responsible for examination matters in field offices may share their Mobile No./Email id with Sr. AO (Exam).
