**Subject :- Consolidation of restored portion of pro-rata pension consequent upon Revision of pay and allowances on the recommendations of Sixth Pay Commission .**

Consequent upon revision of pay and allowances as well as pension/family pension in pursuance of Govt. decision on the recommendation of Sixth Pay Commission, Govt. of West Bengal, in their Finance Department, (Pension Branch) Memorandum No.291-F(Pen),dated 21.7.2020 (copy enclosed) have sanctioned further consolidation of existing **restored portion of pro-rata pension** with effect from **1.1.2020 or from the date on which the amount is restorable, whichever is later, by multiplying with 2.57**. The amount of revised restored portion of prorate pension so arrived at shall be rounded off to next 10 rupee, if the said amount is not multiple of Rs.10/- .Such consolidated amount , however, shall not be stepped up to a minimum pension of Rs.8500/- p.m.

Besides, the above category of Pro-rata pension holders are allowed to get the benefit of **medical relief @ Rs.500/- p.m.** with effect from **1/1/2020** or from the date on which 1/3<sup>rd</sup> commuted portion of pension is restorable, whichever is later and dearness relief on consolidated pension as admissible to the West Bengal Government Pensioners if sanctioned later.

All Pension Disbursing Officers are, therefore, requested to make necessary arrangements for consolidation of already restored pro-rata pension following the above procedure.

Subject : Consolidation of restored portion of Pro-rata pension consequent upon Revision of Pay & Allowances on the recommendations of the 6<sup>th</sup> Pay Commission

The absorbees in Government undertakings who received lump sum amount in lieu of pension under rule 189A of WBS (DCRB) Rules, 1971 were entitled to the restoration of 1/3<sup>rd</sup> commuted portion of pension after 15 years from the date of commutation in terms of Memo No 2430-F(Pen) dated 12.07.2001.

Consequent upon revision of pay and allowances as well as pension / family pension in pursuance of Government decision on the recommendations of the sixth Pay Commission, the Government was in active consideration whether the restored portion of Pro-rata pension be further consolidated. After careful consideration of the matter, the Governor has been pleased to decide that :-

The amount of Pro-rata pension already restored shall be further consolidated w.e.f. 01.01.2020 or from the date on which the amount is restorable whichever is later, by multiplying with 2.57. The amount of revised Pension so arrived at shall be rounded off to next 10 (ten) rupee, if the said amount is not a multiple of ₹ 10 (ten).

Such consolidated amount however, shall not be stepped up to a minimum pension of ₹ 8,500/- p.m.

- ) Relief on Pension and Medical Relief ₹ 500/- p.m. as admissible to State Government Pensioners will be admissible on the consolidated amount of pension w.e.f. 01.01.2020 or from the date on which the 1/3<sup>rd</sup> commuted portion of pension is restorable, whichever is later.
