

As per Government Order cited (1) above Dearness relief payable to State Judicial Pensioners/family pensioners drawing pension in the pre-revised scale was enhanced from 203% to 212% from 01.07.2022. Hence you are requested to honour the claim for enhanced Dearness Relief of State Judicial Pensioners/family pensioners and 203% to 212% to those drawing pre-revised rates with effect from 01.07.2022. The dearness relief at enhanced rates is payable along with the pension for the month of June 2023.

Revised DR at Central Rates as above will not be admissible to State pensioners/family pensioners viz. UGC/AICTE/Medical EDN, PSC etc. till said rates are released by State Government.

ORDER

As per Office Memorandum read 1st above, Government of India enhanced the rate of Dearness Allowance payable to the employees of Central Government and Central Autonomous Bodies, in the pre-revised pay scale from the existing rate of 203% to 212% w.e.f. 01.07.2022. Hence, the rate of Dearness Allowance payable to State Judicial Officers whose pay has not been revised as per the Government Orders read 2nd and 3rd above and the rate of Dearness Relief payable to State Judicial Pensioners are ordered to be enhanced from the existing rate of 203% to 212% with effect from 01.07.2022. The Dearness Allowance at the enhanced rates will be paid along with the salary for the month of May 2023 and the Dearness Relief at the enhanced rates will be paid along with the pension for the month of June 2023. The orders regarding the payment of arrears of this DA/DR revision shall be issued separately.
