Sub: **Grant of Dearness relief to the retired All India Services Pensioners**  
-effective from **01.07.2022** reg:

Ref: 1) OMNo42/07/2022-P&PW(D) dt 08.10.2022  
2) OM No 1/3(1)/2008-EII(B) dt 12.10.2022

As per OM cited (1) above Dearness relief payable to Central Government Pensioners/family pensioners was enhanced from 34% to 38% by (2) above those who continued to draw their pay/pension in pre-revised rates, from 203% to 212% from 01.07.2022. Hence you are requested to honour the claim for enhanced Dearness Relief from 34 % to 38% to Central Government Pensioners/family pensioners and 203% to 212% to those drawing pre-revised rates with effect from 01.07.2022.

Revised DR at Central Rates as above will not be admissible to other categories of State pensioners/family pensioners viz. Retired State Judicial Officers, UGC/AICTE/Medical EDN, PSC etc. till said rates are released by State Government.

**Subject: Revised rates of Dearness Allowance to the employees of Central Government and Central Autonomous Bodies continuing to draw their pay in the pre-revised pay scale/Grade Pay as per 6<sup>th</sup> Central Pay Commission from 01.07.2022**

The undersigned is directed to refer to this Department's O.M. No. 1/3(1)/2008-E.II(B) dated 7<sup>th</sup> April, 2022 on the subject mentioned above and to say that the rate of Dearness Allowance (DA) in respect of employees of Central Government and Central Autonomous Bodies who are continuing to draw their pay in the pre-revised pay scale/Grade Pay as per 6<sup>th</sup> Central Pay Commission, shall be enhanced from the existing rate of 203% to 212% of Basic Pay w.e.f. 01.07.2022.

2. The provisions contained in paras 3, 4 and 5 of this Ministry's O.M.No.1(3)/2008-E.II(B) dated 29<sup>th</sup> August, 2008 shall continue to be applicable while regulating Dearness Allowance under these orders.

3. The contents of this Office Memorandum may also be brought to the notice of all organisations under the administrative control of the Ministries/Departments which have adopted the Central Government scales of pay.

OFFICE MEMORANDUM

**Sub: Grant of Dearness Relief to Central Government pensioners/family pensioners – Revised rate effective from 01.07.2022.**

The undersigned is directed to refer to this Department's OM No. 42/07/2022-P&PW(D) dated 05.04.2022 on the subject mentioned above and to state that the President is pleased to decide that the Dearness Relief admissible to Central Government pensioners/family pensioners shall be enhanced from the existing rate of 34% to 38% w.e.f 01.07.2022.

2. These rates of DR will be applicable to the following categories:-

- i. Civilian Central Government Pensioners/Family Pensioners including Central Govt. absorbee pensioners in PSU/Autonomous Bodies in respect of whom orders have been issued vide this Department's OM No. 4/34/2002-P&PW(D) Vol.II dated 23.06.2017 for restoration of full pension after expiry of commutation period of 15 years.
- ii. The Armed Forces Pensioners, Civilian Pensioners paid out of the Defence Service Estimates.
- iii. All India Service Pensioners
- iv. Railway Pensioners/family pensioners
- v. Pensioners who are in receipt of provisional pension
- vi. The Burma Civilian pensioners/family pensioners and pensioners/families of displaced Government Pensioners from Burma/ Pakistan, in respect of whom orders have been issued vide this Department's OM No. 23/3/2008-P&PW(B) dated 11.09.2017.

3. The payment of Dearness Relief involving a fraction of a rupee shall be rounded off to the next higher rupee.

4. Other provisions governing grant of DR in respect of employed family pensioners and re-employed Central Government Pensioners will be regulated in accordance with the provisions contained in Rule 52 of CCS (Pension) Rules, 2021 and this Department's OM No. 45/73/97-P&PW (G) dated 2.7.1999 as amended from time to time. The provisions relating to regulation of DR where a pensioner is in receipt of more than one pension will remain unchanged.

5. In the case of retired Judges of the Supreme Court and High Courts, necessary orders will be issued by the Department of Justice separately.


Sir,

I am directed to refer to this Department's letter of even number dated 12<sup>th</sup> April, 2022 on the above subject and to say that Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure, vide O.M. No. 1/3/2022-E-II (B) dated 3<sup>rd</sup> October, 2022 (copy enclosed) has revised the rates of Dearness Allowance (D.A.) payable to Central Government employees and to the members of All India Services. The Dearness Allowance has been revised from 34% to 38% of the basic pay w.e.f. 01.07.2022. The payment on account of Dearness Allowance involving fractions of 50 paise and above may be rounded to the next higher rupee and the fractions of less than 50 paise may be ignored.

2. By virtue of the provisions contained in Rule 2 of High Court Judges Rules, 1956 and Rule 6 of the Supreme Court Judges Rules, 1959, the Judges of the High Courts and Supreme Court are also entitled to the revised rates of Dearness Allowance w.e.f. 01.07.2022 at the same rates (38%) as are admissible to the members of All India Service. The admissibility of Dearness Allowance would be subject to other conditions as stipulated by Department of expenditure's above mentioned O.M.

3. This issues with the concurrence of Joint Secretary and Financial Adviser (Law) vide note No. 79 dated 19.10.2022 (e-file no. 3831) and approval of Secretary (Justice) vide note No. 82 dated 20.10.2022.
