

**Minutes of the meeting of the Departmental Screening Committee held on 22.05.2024 in the O/o the Accountant General (Audit), Assam, to consider the cases of Compassionate Appointment.**

A meeting of the Screening Committee consisting of Shri Hari Prakash, Sr. Dy. Accountant General, O/o the Pr. Accountant General (A&E), Assam (Chairperson), Shri Uttam Chanda, Director, O/o the Director General of Audit, NF Railway, Maligaon, Guwahati (Member) and Shri Binod Bhujel, Deputy Accountant General, O/o the Accountant General (Audit), Assam (Member) was held at the chamber of the Sr. Dy. Accountant General (Administration), O/o Pr. Accountant General (A&E), Assam on 22.05.2024 to consider the case of Ms. Bipasa Saha Roy, D/o Late Biplob Kumar Saha Roy, Ex- Asstt. Supervisor, for the purpose of compassionate appointment in the Office of the Accountant General (Audit), Assam, Guwahati.

The Committee was informed that there is only one eligible case for the purpose of compassionate appointment for consideration of the Committee, as has been stated above.

1. That as per Para (7) of Compassionate Appointment Scheme's consolidated guidelines issued under DoPT's O.M No 14014/1/2022-Estt. (D) dated 02.08.2022, Compassionate Appointment can be made up to a maximum of 5% of DR vacancy falling in Direct Recruitment quota in any Group "C" post. Further, that the ceiling of 5per cent of Direct Recruitment vacancies for making compassionate appointment should not be exceeded by utilizing any other vacancy, e.g., sports quota vacancy.
2. That there are **04 (FOUR)** vacancies for the **Year 2024** in this Office for grant of Compassionate Appointment. (Statement-I).
3. The Committee was further informed that The Welfare Officer has assessed the financial position of the family and submitted report stating that the information as has been furnished in Form "A" by the applicant Ms. Bipasa Saha Roy, D/o Late Biplob Kumar Saha Roy, Ex-Asstt. Supervisor, had been verified and had stated that Rs. 34,00,000/- was due towards the cost of 3 BHK flat at Binovanagar, Guwahati, for which cost of Registration & Mutation was Rs. 2,70,000/- and a loan from relative was there, amounting to Rs. 2,75,000/-, which were the liabilities upon the family members of the deceased employee at the time of the DSC meeting held on September 2022. However, the current liability in the case of the above-stated flat as per the applicant's letter dated 20/11/2023 is one loan amounting to Rs. 11,95,000/-, EMI in respect of which is Rs. 23,322/- per month from the family pension which is for a period up to 15 years and the present valuation of the Flat is Rs. 49,69,000/-.

Out of the above 82 posts, 02 (two) posts are kept aside for Sports Quota Recruitment as per HQs letter issued under No. 688/Welfare/8-Sports/2016 dated 27.12.2016, Point no. 3(a) of which *inter alia* states that the recruitment under sports quota in an office in a calendar year shall be limited to 01 person for sanctioned strength of 200 of the concerned office in Group 'B' and 'C' cadres. The total Sanctioned Strength of group 'B' and Group 'C' posts of this office is **495 as on 01.01.2024**. Therefore, calculation for compassionate Appointment for the Year 2024 is to be done on the vacant posts of direct recruitment of group 'C' posts of **82-2=80**. **Accordingly, 5% of 80= 04 number of posts are there for appointment under Compassionate Ground in this office for the Panel Year 2024.**
