Sub: Complaint Mechanism for Redressal of complaints of Sexual Harassment of working women.

In supersession of this Office Circular No. AG/A&E)/Committee/Conduct Rules/17-18/12 dated 23.11.2017 and in continuation of Headquarters Office Circular No.137 Audit (Rules)/8-98/III-98(44) dated 25.05.1998 read with Headquarters Circular No. NGE37/1998 No.91-NGE-Disc/13-98 dated 22.07.1998 on the subject cited above, the following information is notified herewith for the notice of all members of this office.

Based on the guidelines and norms laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court, which were communicated in Headquarters Circular No.91-JNGE-Disc/13-98 dated 22.07.1998, the Committee for Redressal of complaints of Sexual Harassment of working women of this office is reconstituted with Smt. Yashoda, Senior Deputy Accountant General (A/Cs & VLC), Office of the Principal Accountant General (A&E), Karnataka, Bengaluru, as Chairperson for giving effect to the mechanism to investigate charges of sexual harassment of women employees at work place.


