Subject : Grant of Dearness Relief to the Bihar Govt. pensioners/
family pensioners with effect from 01-07-2011.

In continuation to this office circular No. Pen. Co-ordn./Bihar/Vol.- VIII/DR/123 dated 02-09-2011, this is to state that the Govt. of Bihar in their FD Resolution No. 3A-3-Allowance-01/2009 - 9634-B dated 18-10-2011 have sanctioned dearness relief to their pensioners/family pensioners whose pension have been revised in the light of Bihar Govt. F D Resolution No. B.-27/Pay Co.-137/2008-819 and 820 both dated 23-09-2009 at the rate and from the date as under :-

Date of effect	Rate of Dearness Relief per month
01-07-2011	58% of basic pension/family pension

2. Payment of dearness relief involving fraction of 50 paise and above may be rounded off to the next higher rupee and fraction less than 50 paise may be ignored.

3. Dearness relief will not be admissible to the re-employed pensioners. Except this, dearness relief will be admissible to the rest of the civil pensioners who are getting compensatory pension, old age pension, retired pension and disabled pension. This relief is also admissible to the pensioners getting provisional pension/family pension and extra ordinary pension.

4. So far as application of this order in respect of the retired employees of the High Court/Bihar Legislative Assembly/Bihar Legislative Council is concerned, necessary orders will be issued separately by the respective secretariat/office after obtaining the concurrence of the Chief Justice, Patna High Court/Speaker, Bihar Legislative Assembly/Chairman, Bihar Legislative Council, Bihar, Patna.

5. Incidentally, it may be mentioned that this circular is issued to other Accountants General just to remind them the applicability of this order to the West Bengal Govt. pensioners/family pensioners guided by Bihar Pension Rules.

6. Having been authorised by the Accountant General (A&E)-II, Bihar in their letter No. Pen-IX-Spl. Seal Authority No. 895 dated 31-10-2011, it is requested to make necessary arrangement for payment of dearness relief @ 58% with effect from 01-07-2011 to all eligible Bihar Govt. pensioners/family pensioners as well as West Bengal Govt. pensioners/family pensioners guided by Bihar Pension Rules on their pension/family pension and after proper adjustment.

7. The charges on this account for the pensioners/family pensioners of Govt. of Bihar are debitable to the Govt. of Bihar under the head "8793-I.S.S.A/cs.; Govt. of Bihar etc" and the charges for the West Bengal Govt. pensioners/family pensioners guided by Bihar Pension Rules are debitable to the Govt. of West Bengal under the head "2071-Pension and Other Retirement Benefits".
