OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: - Grant of Dearness Relief to Himachal Pradesh AIS Pensioners/Family Pensioners-Revised rate effective from 01.07.2021.

- In continuation of this department's O.M. No. Fin (Pen)B(10)-6/98-IV dated 7th March, 2020, the Governor, Himachal Pradesh, is pleased to enhance the dearness relief @ 14% from the existing rate of 17% to 31% with effect from 01st July, 2021 in respect of Pensioners/Family Pensioners of AIS Cadre Officers of the Himachal Pradesh, who are drawing revised pension/family pension based on 7th Central Pay Commission Report, in terms of the Govt. of India O.M. No. 42/07/2021-P&PW(D) dated 22.07.2021 and O.M. No. 42/07/2021-P&PW(D) dated 22.07.2021 and O.M. No. 42/07/2021-P&PW(D) e-7330 dated 27th October, 2021.
- 2. Payment of Dearness relief involving a fraction of a rupee shall be rounded off to the next higher rupee.
- 3. Other provisions governing grant of dearness relief to pensioners such as regulation of dearness relief during employment/re-employment, regulation of dearness relief where more than one pension is drawn etc. will remain unchanged.
- 4. As dearness relief will now be at a uniform rate, it has been decided to dispense with the issue of enclosing ready reckoner along with the dearness relief orders. It will be the responsibility of the Pension Disbursing Authority (PDA), including the Nationalized Banks, etc. to calculate the quantum of dearness relief payable in each individual case.
- 5. The additional dearness relief shall be paid with the pension/family pension for the month of December, 2021 payable in the month of January, 2022. The arrears accrued

on account of dearness relief w.e.f. 01-07-2021 to 31-12-2021 shall be paid in one installment along with the pension / family pension for the month of December, 2021 payable in the month of January, 2022.

6. The Accountant General, (A&E) H.P, Treasury Officers and authorized Public Sector Banks are requested to arrange the payment of Dearness Relief to pensioners on the basis of these orders.



The undersigned is directed to state that the Governor, Himnehal Pradesh is pleased to decide that the Dearness Relief (DR) at revised rates to Himnehal Pradesh Government pensioners/ family pensioners shall be paid w.e.f. 01.01.2016, as indicated below:-

Note: -Dearness Relief at revised rates, as shown in table above, shall also be payable on additional pension/additional family pension available to older pensioners/ family pensioners who have completed the age of 80 year and above, based on their age as indicated in this Department O.M. Nos. Fin(Pen)A(3)-1/2021-Part-1 and Part-II dated 25.02.2022.

2. The payment of Dearness Relief(DR) under these orders from the dates indicated above shall be made after adjusting the instalments of enhanced Dearness Relief(DR) already sanctioned and paid to Himachal Pradesh Government pensioners/family pensioners w.e.f. 01.01.2016 vide O.M. No. Fin (Pen) B (10)-6/98-III dated 03.10.2016, w.e.f. 01.07.2016 vide O.M. No. Fin (Pen) B (10)-6/98-III dated 19.01.2017 & O.M. of even number 07.04.2017, w.e.f. 01.01.2017 vide O.M. No. Fin (Pen) B (10)-6/98-III dated 08.01.2018, w.e.f. 01.01.2018 vide O.M. No. Fin (Pen) B (10)-6/98-III dated 08.01.2018, w.e.f. 01.01.2018 vide O.M. - 3. Payment of Dearness Relief involving a fraction of rupee shall be rounded off to the next higher rupee.
- 4. Other provisions governing grant of Dearness Relief to pensioners such as regulation of Dearness Relief during employment/re-employment, regulation of dearness relief where more than one pension is drawn etc. will remain unchanged.
- 5. These orders shall apply to all Himachal Pradesh Government pensioners/ family pensioners whose pension/ family pension has been revised in terms of Finance (Pension) Department O.M. Nos. Fin(Pen)A(3)-1/2021-Part-I and Part-II dated 25.02.2022.
- 6. It will be the responsibility of the Pension Disbursing Authority, including the Nationalized Banks, etc. to calculate the quantum of Dearness Relief payable in each individual case.
- 7. The Principal Accountant General (A&E) H.P., Distt. Treasury Officers and authorised Public Sector Banks are requested to arrange payment of Dearness Relief to pensioners/family pensioners on the basis of these orders immediately.
- 8. In view of the orders of O.M. Nos. Fin(Pen)A(3)-1/2021-Part-I and Part-II dated 25.02.2022 the revised pension will be paid w.e.f. 01-02-2022. This revised pension will also include the Dearness Relief(DR) component of 31%. In case, the total un-revised pension of a pensioner exceeds the total revised pension due to payment of interim relief, extra amount, if any, will be set off against increase in pension of the concerned pensioner by way of future release of Dearness Relief(DR), payment of arrears of pension or due to any other increase etc.



OTTICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Revision of pension and family pension of pre-1046 pensioners/family pensioners w.e.f. 01.01.2016.

- 1. The undersigned is directed to say that Governor, Himachal Prodesh is pleased to accord sanction for regulation of pension family pension of the pre-2016 bensioner (family pensioners) with effect from 01.01.2016, in the manner as indicated in the succeeding paragraphs. Separate orders have been issued in respect of employees who are retired affect on or after 01.01.2016.
- 2. These orders shall apply to all pensioners family pensioners who were drawing pension family pension as on 0°.01.2016 under the Central Civil Services (Pens., r.) R.Jes. 1972.
- In these orders:

- (a) texisting pensioner or texisting family pensioner means a pensioner to whom these orders are applied by in terms of Para 2, do we and who was drawing or entitled to pension family pension on 34.12.2015.
- (b) 'existing pension' or 'existing family pension' means the basic pension (inclusive of communed portion, if any) or basic family pension due or, 31.12.2015.
- 1.1 The pension family pension of pre-2016 pensioners that it y pensioners shall be revised w.e.f. 01.01.2016, by multiplying the existing basic pension basic family pension due on 31.12.2015 by a factor 2.57. The amount of revised pension family pension so arrived at single be rounded off to next his fer rapec.

- 4.2 For this purpose, the existing pension family pension will be the basic pension family pension without the element of additional pension family pension as additional pension family pensioners family pensioners of the age of 80 years and above. The additional pension family pension payable to the old pensioners family pensioners will be worked out in accordance with para 4.5 of this Office Memorandom.
- 4.3 Since the consolidated pension will be inclusive of commuted portion of pension of any, the commuted portion will be deducted from the said amount while making monthly disbursement of pension.
- 4.4 The minimum pension with effect from 01.01.2016 will be Rs. 9000 PM texcluding the element of additional pension to old pensioners). The upper celling on pension facility pension will be 50% and 30% of highest pay Rs. 2.24.100 with effect from 01.01.2016.
- 4.5 The quantum of additional pension family pension available to the old pensioners family pensioners, attaining age of 80 years and above shall continue to be as follows:

Age of pensioner

From 80 years to less than 85 years
From 85 years to less than 90 years
From 90 years to less than 95 years
From 95 years to less than 100 years
100 years or more

Additional quantum of pension 20% of basic pension family pension 30% of basic pension family pension 40% of basic pension family pension 50% of basic pension family pension 100% of basic pension, family pension

(6) FAMILY PESSION

In cases where, on permanent absorption in public sector undertakings autonomous bodies, the terms of absorption and/or the rade permit grant of family pension under the CCS (Pension) Rules, 1972, the family pension being drawn by family pensioners will be updated in accordance with these orders.

- 8.1 All Pension Disbursing Authorities including Public Sector Banks bandling disbursement of pension to the State Government pensioners are hereby authorised to pay pension family pension to existing pensioners family pensioners at the revised rate on terms of para 4.1 and 5 above without any further authorisation from the concerned Accounts Officers Head of Office etc.
- 8.2 Where a pensioner is in receipt of more than one pension, consolidation may be done separately in terms of paragraph 4.1 and as indicated in paragraph 5 above, door deiling of Rs,0000 may be applied to total pension from all sources taken together.
- 8.3 Where the age of pensioner tamily pensioner is available on the pension payment order, the additional pension/family pension in terms of para 4.5 above may also be paid by the Pension Disbursing Authorities immediately without any further authorisation from the concerned Accounts Officer Head of Office, etc. A suitable entry regarding the revised consolidated pension shall be recorded by the Pension Disbursing Authorities in both halves of the Pension Payment Order (PPO). An intimation regarding disbursement of revised pension may be sent by the Pension Disbursing Authorities to the office of the Principal Accountant General (A&C) (HP) which had issued the PPO, so, that the latter can update the Pension Payment Order register manualized by him. An adknowledgement shall be obtained by the Pension Disbursing Authorities from the office of the Principal Accountant General (A&C), H.P., in this behalf.
- 8.4 In any case, information regarding date of birth is not available, the Pension Disbursing Authority may obtain the same from the Principal Accountant General (A&L). H.P. Head of office. It will be the responsibility of the aforesaid offices to provide the information from the available records within formight of the receipt of request from the Pension Disbursing Authority.

The amount of additional pension will be shown distinctly in the pension payment order. For example, in case where a pensioner is more than 80 years of age and his her revised pension in terms para 4.1 above is Rs.20,000,- per month, the pension will be shown as (i). Basic pension Rs. 20,000 - PM and (ii) Additional pension Rs.4,000 PM. The pension on his her attaining the ape of 85 years will be shown as (i). Basic Pension Rs.20,000 PM and (ii) additional pension Rs.6,000 PM. The Dearness relief will be admissible on the additional pension family pension.

- 4.6 The dearness relief, at revised rates shall be payable w.e.f 01.01.2016 on the revises pension family pension as arrived at as per paragraph 4.1.
- 4.7 The Interim Relief a 21% already granted on basic pension basic family pension to Government pensioners family pensioners from time to time half 5a adjusted against the revised pension family pension consolidated in terms of para 4.1 and extra payments, if any, shall be adjusted against arrears of the pension family pension and future increases in dearness relief of the concerned pensioner family pensioner to be released in date conts of time.
- 5. Where the revised pension limity pension in terms of paragraph 4.1 above works out to an amount less than Rs. 9000 %, the same shall be stepped up to Rs. 9000 %. This will be regarded as basic pension family pension with effect from 01.01.2016
- 6. The existing instructions regarding regulation of dearness relief to employed reemployed pensioners/family pensioners, as amended from time to time, shall continue to apply.
- The cases of the State Government employees who have been permanently absorbed in public sector undertakings autonomous hodies will be reputated as follows: -

co PENSION

Where the Government servants on permanent absorption in public sector undertakings a nonomous podies continue to draw peris on separately from the Government, the pension of such absorbces will be updated in terms of these orders. In cases, where the Government servants have drawn one-time lump-sum terminal benefits equal to 100% of their pensions and become entitled to the restoration of one-third commuted portion of per conas, per the instructions issued by this Department from time to time, their

Revision of provisions regulating Pension/ Gratuity. Commutation of Pension and Family Pension.

The undersigned is directed to state that the Governor, Himachal Prodesh is pleased to introduce the following modifications in the Rules regulating Pension, Retirement *Death* Service Gratuity and Family Pension under the C.C.S. (Pension) Rules, 1972 thereafter referred to as Pension Rules) and the Commutation of Pension under the CCS (Commutation of Pension) Rules, 1981.

2.000 . These orders shall apply to the Himachal Pradesh Government employees governed by the CCS (Pension) $\rm Ra^2cs/19\,\%$

DATE OF EFFECT

- 3.1 The revised provisions as per these orders shall apply to Covernment servants who retire/die in harness on or after 01.01.2016. Separate orders are being issued in respect of the employees who retired died be ore 01.01.2616.
- 3.2 Where pension gratuity commutation and family pension has already been sanctioned in the cases occurring on or after 01.01.2016 the same shall be revised in terms of these orders. In cases, where pension has been finally sanctioned on the pre-revised orders and if it happens to be more beneficial than the pension becoming due under these orders, the pension already sanctioned shall not be revised to the disadvantage of the pensioners in view of the provisions contained under Rule 70 of the CCS (Pension) Rules, 1972.

EMOLUMENTS

- The term Lincolaments' for the purposes of calculating various pensionary benefits other than various kinds of gramity shall have the same meaning as in Rule the 33 of the Central Civil Services (Pension) Rules, 1972 read with instructions contained in the Government ON No. Fin (Pen) A (3)-12 2010 dued 12th March, 2013.
- 4.2 The 'Basic Pay' in the revised pay structure means the pay drawn in the prescribes 'Levels' of the Pay Matrix with effect from 01.01.2016, but does not include any other type of pay like special pay etc.

4.3 In the case of all kinds of gratuity, dearness allowance admissible on the date of retirement/death shall continue to be treated as emoluments/along with the emoluments as defined in Paragraph 4.4 arove.

PENSION

- 5.1 Subject to para 5.2 below, there shall be no change in the provisions regulating the amount of pension as contained in Rule the 49 of the CCS(Pension) Rules 1972.
- 5.2 The amount of pension shall be subject to a minimum of Rs. 9,000 -PM and the maximum pension will be Rs. 112050;-PM (i.e. 50% of the Rs. 2.24.100/-). The provisions of the sub-rule (2) of Rule 49 of the CCS (Pension) Rules, 1972 shall stand modified to this extent.
- 5.3 The quantum of the additional pension family pension available to the old pensioners: family pensioners attaining the age of 80 years and above shall continue to be as follows: -

Age of pensioner	Additional quantum of pension/ family pension
From 80 years to less than 85 years From 85 years to less than 90 years	20% of basic pension-family pension 30% of basic pension/family pension
From 90 years to less than 95 years	40% of basic pension/family pension
From 95 years to less than 100 years 100 years or more	2.50% of basic pension/family pension 100% of basic pension/family pension:

The Pension Sanctioning Authorities shall ensure that the date of birth and the age of a pensioner is invariably indicated in the Pension Payment Order (PPO) to facilitate payment of additional pension by the Pension Disbursing Authority, as soon as it becomes due. The amount of additional pension will be shown distinctly in the pension payment order. For example: in ease where a pensioner is more than 80 years of age and his pension is Rs. 20,000 - PM, the pension will be shown as (i) basic pension. Rs. 20,000 - PM and (ii) Additional pension. Rs. 4,000 - PM. The pension, on attaining the age of 85 years, will be shown as (i) basic pension. Rs. 20,000-PM and (ii) additional pension. Rs. 6,000 - PM.





 Kindly refer the circular No. 3/2/92-Fin(Exp)/Part File-IV 7th September 2021 and Circular No. 3/2/92-Fin(Exp)/Part File-IV 17th November 2021 issued from the office of the Government of Goa. Finance (Expenditure) Department Secretariat. Porvorim - Goa, has conveyed the sanction for revision of Dearness allowance to the employees of State Government and its Autonomous bodies who continue to draw their pay and allowances in the pre-revised scale as per the 6th Central Pay Commission.

Now as per para 3 of the said circulars dated 07/09/2021 and 17/11/2021 Government of Goa has decided to 'EXTEND' the Office Memoranda of Dearness Allowance which is issued by Finance (Expenditure) Department from time to time for the employees of State Government and its Autonomous bodies who continue to draw their pay and allowances in the pre-revised scale as per the 6th Central Pay Commission for grant of Dearness Relief to pensioners of the Autonomous bodies / Corporations who are in pre-revised scale as per the 6th Central Pay Commission, under their administrative control, inorder to resolve the hardship faced by the pensioner of Autonomous bodies / Corporations. The copy of the said circular dated 07/09/2021 and 17/11/2021 are enclosed for information and necessary action.

- 2. Since the order on relief contained in the above Finance (Expenditure) Department are applicable to the employees / pensioners and Family Pensioners of State Government and its Autonomous bodies who continue to draw their pay and allowances and pension & Pensionery benefits in the pre-revised scale as per the 6th Central Pay Commission and drawing Dearness Relief at the rate of 164%, I am to authorize you to pay Pensioners / Family Pensioners of State Government and its Autonomous bodies / Corporation the revised rates of Dearness Relief which has been enhanced from i.e. 164% to 189% w.e.f. 01/07/2021 vide order no. 3/2/92-Fin(Exp)/Part File-IV dated 7th September 2021 and further the above Dearness Relief is enhanced from 189% to 196% w.e.f. 01/07/2021 vide order no. 3/2/92-Fin(Exp)/Part File-IV dated 17th November 2021.  - e. Freedom Fighters of Govt. of Goa.


