**Sub: - Grant of Dearness Relief to State Government Pensioners/
Family Pensioners - Revised rate effective from 01/01/2019.**

1. The Government of Goa, Finance (Rev. & Cont.) Department Secretariat, Porvorim, vide letter No. 12/3/82-Fin(R&C)Vol. I / 2706 dated 11th April 2019 has conveyed the sanction for revision of Dearness Relief to the Pensioners/Family Pensioners of Goa Government as contained in Office Memorandum No. 42/04/2019-P&PW(D) dated 6th March 2019 issued by Government of India, Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions, Department of Pension, & Pensioners Welfare, New Delhi. The copy of the said Office Memorandum is enclosed for information and necessary action.


2. Since the order on relief contained in the above Government of India's Office Memorandum are applicable to Goa Government Pensioners and Family Pensioners, I am to authorize you to pay to the Goa Government Pensioners/Family Pensioners the installment of 3% of Dearness Relief raising it to 12% with effect from 01/01/2019 or date of commencement of pension whichever is later. The Dearness Relief @12% to be paid to the pensioners with arrears effective from 01/01/2019 to 31/03/2019 alongwith pension for the month of April 2019. Further, the sanction conveyed vide letter No. 12/3/82-Fin(R&C) Vol. I / 2706 dated 11th April 2019 is also applicable to the following pensioners and should be paid relief accordingly.
 - (a). Ex-gratia pensioners (Montepio pensioners, pensioners drawing pensions on account of service rendered to Portuguese colonies and institute Ultramarine Pensioners) drawing pensions under C/B/D and E series.
 - (b). Pensao de Sanguie pensioners.
 - (c). Pensioners receiving pension under triple benefit scheme.
 - (d). Recipients of Ex-gratia i.e. Families of deceases pensioners/employees who were governed under EFU.
 - (e). Pensioners sanctioned pension under Education Act 15 of 1985 and drawing pension under series T.


3. In case of Goa State Government Pensioners drawing pension in other States, the instructions contained in above Office Memorandum may be issued to all the Treasuries/Sub-Treasuries/P.A.O where they are drawing their monthly pension.

4. This Dearness relief is not applicable to the following class of pensioners.
 - a. Pensioners drawing pension, which is granted after Independence for Political consideration(Ex-Rulers).
 - b. Retired High Court and Supreme Court Judges for whom order will be issued separately by administrative authorities concerned.
 - c. Pensioners of other states (PAO) Suspense) for whom separate orders are applicable.
 - d. M.L.A. Pensioners.
 - e. Freedom Fighters of Govt. of Goa.
5. Instructions issued from time to time by this office as regards to payment of relief should be observed.
6. Wide Publicity may be given to this circular letter by displaying a copy on the office notice board or other permanent place in your office.
7. Pensioners who have drawn part payment of their pension through Treasury Office after 01/01/2019 and have subsequently opted for payment of their pension through Bank may also be paid arrears from the date of their retirement or from 01/01/2019 whichever is earlier without waiting for any individual orders from this office.



OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Sub: Grant of Dearness Relief to Central Government pensioners/ family pensioners – Revised rate effective from 01.01.2019 –reg.

The undersigned is directed to refer to this Department's OM No.42/06/2018-P&PW(G) dated 18.09.2018 on the subject mentioned above and to state that the President is pleased to decide that the Dearness Relief admissible to Central Government pensioners/ family pensioners shall be enhanced from the existing rate of 9% to 12% w.e.f. 01.01.2019.

2. These rates of DR will be applicable to (i) Civilian Central Government Pensioners/ Family Pensioners including Central Govt. absorbee pensioners in PSU/ Autonomous Bodies in respect of whom orders have been issued vide this Department's OM No.4/34/2002-P&PW(D) Vol.II dated 23.06.2017 for restoration of full pension after expiry of commutation period of 15 years (ii) The Armed Forces Pensioners, Civilian Pensioners paid out of the Defence Service Estimates, (iii) All India Service Pensioners (iv) Railway Pensioners/ family pensioners (v) Pensioners who are in receipt of provisional pension (vi) The Burma Civilian pensioners/ family pensioners and pensioners/ families of displaced Government Pensioners from Burma/ Pakistan, in respect of whom orders have been issued vide this Department's OM No.23/3/2008-P&PW(B) dated 11.09.2017.

3. The payment of Dearness Relief involving a fraction of a rupee shall be rounded off to the next higher rupee.

4. The payment of arrears of Dearness Relief shall not be made before the date of disbursement of pension/ family pension of March, 2019.
5. Other provisions governing grant of DR in respect of employed family pensioners and re-employed Central Government Pensioners will be regulated in accordance with the provisions contained in this Department's OM No.45/73/97-P&PW(G) dated 2.7.1999 as amended vide this Department's OM No.F.No.38/88/2008-P&PW(G) dated 9th July, 2009. The provisions relating to regulation of DR where a pensioner is in receipt of more than one pension will remain unchanged.
6. In the case of retired Judges of the Supreme Court and High Courts, necessary orders will be issued by the Department of Justice separately.
7. It will be the responsibility of the pension disbursing authorities, including the nationalized banks, etc. to calculate the quantum of DR payable in each individual case.
8. The offices of Accountant General and authorised Pension Disbursing Banks are requested to arrange payment of relief to pensioners etc. on the basis of these instructions without waiting for any further instructions from the Comptroller and Auditor General of India and the Reserve Bank of India in view of letter No.528-TA,II/34-80-II dated 23/04/1981 of the Comptroller and Auditor General of India addressed to all Accountant Generals and Reserve Bank of India Circular No.GANB No.2958/GA-64 (ii) (CGL)/81 dated the 21st May, 1981 addressed to State Bank of India and its subsidiaries and all Nationalised Banks.
9. In their application to the pensioners/ family pensioners belonging to Indian Audit and Accounts Department, these orders issue after consultation with the C&AG.
10. This issues in accordance with Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure's OM No.1/1/2019-E.II(B) dated 27th Feb., 2019.
