Subject: Grant of dearness relief on pension/family pension to the pensioners/family pensioners of Non Govt. Colleges w.e.f. 1.1.2015

In continuation to this office. Circular No. Pen.Co-ordn./51/Vol-V/204/Vol-II/209 dated 21/2/2014 it is stated that Govt. of West Bengal in their Higher Education Department Memo no. 97-Edn(CS)/1P-1/2013, dated 27/01/2015 have sanctioned dearness relief to the pensioners/family pensioners of the teaching and non-teaching staff of the State-Aided Non-Government. Colleges in this State @ 65% with effect from 1/1/2015.

All concerned Pension Disbursing Officers are, therefore, requested to allow to the above categories of pensioners/family pensioners dearness relief @ 65% with effect from 1/1/2015, subject to proper adjustment of dearness relief already paid.

Payment of dearness relief on pension/family pension involving a fraction of rupee shall be rounded off to the next higher rupee

Other provisions governing grant of dearness relief to the pensioners/family pensioners not mentioned in this order, such as regulation of relief during re-employment, regulation of relief where more than in pension is drawn etc., will remain unchanged.
