
**Sub: - Grant of Dearness Relief to State Government Pensioners
Family Pensioners - Revised rate effective from 01/01/2019.**

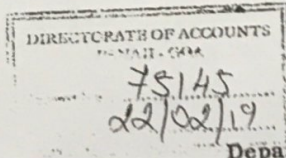
1. Kindly refer to the Circular No 12/1/2019-Fin(R&C) dated 11/02/2019 issued from the office of the Dept. of Finance (Rev. & Control), Govt of Goa, Secretariat Porvorim, circulated by this office vide circular No. DA/PA-I/Pens/19-20/TR-220/DR-140 dtd 09/07/2019 wherein the Government of Goa, Finance(Expenditure) Department, Secretariat, Porvorim, vide Office Memoranda No.3/2/92-Fin (Exp)/Part File-IV dated 17th April,2019 and Office Memorandum No.3/2/92-Fin(Exp)/Part File-IV dtd 19th November, 2019 has conveyed the sanction for revision of Dearness allowance to the employees of State Government and its Autonomous bodies who continue to draw their pay and allowances in the pre-revised scale as per the 6th Central Pay Commission.

Now as per para 3 of the said circular dtd 11/02/2019 Government of Goa has decided to 'EXTEND' the Office Memoranda of Dearness Allowance which is issued by Finance (Expenditure) Department from time to time for the employees of State Government and its Autonomous bodies who continue to draw their pay and allowances in the pre-revised scale of pay as per 6th Central Pay Commission, for grant of Dearness Relief to pensioners of the Autonomous bodies/ Corporations who are in pre-revised pension as per 6th Central Pay Commission, under their administrative control, in order to resolve the hardship faced by the pensioner of Autonomous bodies/ Corporations. The copy of the said circular dated 11/02/2019 and Office Memorandums are enclosed for information and necessary action.

2. Since the order on relief contained in the above Finance(Expenditure) Department Memorandum are applicable to the employees / pensioners and Family Pensioners of the State Government and its Autonomous bodies/ Corporation who continue to draw their pay and allowances in the pre-revised scale of pay as per 6th Central Pay Commission and drawing Dearness Relief at the rate of 148%, I am to authorize you to pay Pensioners/ Family pensioners of State Government and its autonomous bodies / Corporation the revised rates of Dearness Allowances which has been enhanced from time to time i.e. 154% w.e.f. 01/01/2019, the installment of 6% of Dearness Relief raising it to 154% w.e.f 01/01/2019 and 164% w.e.f 01/07/2019, the installment of 10% of Dearness Relief raising it to 164% w.e.f 01/07/2019 or date of commencement of pension whichever is later.
3. In case of Goa State Government Pensioners drawing pension in other States, the instructions contained in above Office Memorandum may be issued to all the Treasuries/Sub-Treasuries/P.A.O where they are drawing their monthly pension.

4. This Dearness relief is not applicable to the following class of pensioners.
 - a. Pensioners drawing pension, which is granted after Independence for Political consideration(Ex-Rulers).
 - b. Retired High Court and Supreme Court Judges for whom order will be issued separately by administrative authorities concerned.
 - c. Pensioners of other states (PAO) Suspense) for whom separate orders are applicable.
 - d. M.L.A. Pensioners.
 - e. Freedom Fighters of Govt. of Goa.
5. Instructions issued from time to time by this office as regards to payment of relief should be observed.
6. Wide Publicity may be given to this circular letter by displaying a copy on the office notice board or other permanent place in your office.

CIRCULAR

References have been received in Finance Department seeking clarification on grant of Dearness Relief (DR) to the Pensioners/ Family Pensioners of Autonomous Bodies who are in receipt of pension in pre-revised pay structure/ scales of 6th Central Pay Commission.

2. Whereas, the Finance (Expenditure) Department issues Office Memoranda from time to time for Dearness Allowance in respect of the employees of State Government and its Autonomous bodies who continue to draw their pay and allowances in the pre-revised scale of pay as per 6th Central Pay Commission. The rate of Dearness Allowances has been enhanced from time to time i.e. 125% w.e.f. 01/01/2016, 132% w.e.f. 01/07/2016, 136% w.e.f. 01/01/2017, 139% w.e.f. 01/07/2017, 142% w.e.f. 01/01/2018 and 148% w.e.f. 01/07/2018, in respect of the employees of State Government and its Autonomous bodies who continue to draw their pay and allowances in the pre-revised scale of pay as per 6th Central Pay Commission. However, the pensioners who are drawing pre-revised pension as per 6th CPC are getting DR at rate of 125%.

3. The matter has been considered in this Department. To resolve the hardship being faced by the pensioners of Autonomous bodies/ Corporations, it has been decided by the Government to extend the Office Memoranda of Dearness Allowance issued by the Finance (Expenditure) Department from time to time for the employees of State Government and its Autonomous bodies who continue to draw their pay and allowances in the pre-revised scale of pay as per 6th Central Pay Commission, for grant of Dearness Relief to pensioners of the Autonomous bodies/ Corporations who are in pre-revised pension as per 6th Central Pay Commission, under their administrative control.

Subject:- Rate of Dearness Allowance applicable w.e.f. 01.01.2019 to the employees of Central Government and Central Autonomous Bodies continuing to draw their pay in the pre-revised pay scale/Grade Pay as per 6th Central Pay Commission.

The undersigned is directed to refer to this Department's O.M. No.1/3/2008-E.II(B) dated 11th September, 2018 revising the rate of Dearness Allowance (DA) w.e.f. 01.07.2018 in respect of employees of Central Government and Central Autonomous Bodies continuing to draw their pay in the pre-revised pay scale/Grade Pay **as per 6th Central Pay Commission**.

2. The rate of DA admissible to above categories of employees of Central Government and Central Autonomous Bodies shall be enhanced from the existing 148% **to 154% w.e.f. 01.01.2019**.

3. The provisions contained in paras 3,4 and 5 of this Ministry's O.M. No.1(3)/2008-E.II(B) dated 29th August, 2008 shall continue to be applicable while regulating Dearness Allowance under these orders.

4. The payment of arrears of Dearness Allowance shall not be made before the date of disbursement of salary of March, 2019

5. The contents of this Office Memorandum may also be brought to the notice of all organisations under the administrative control of the Ministries/Departments which have adopted the Central Government scales of pay.

The undersigned is directed to refer to this Department's O.M. No.13(1)/2008-E.II(B) dated 8th March, 2019 revising the rate of Dearness Allowance (DA) w.e.f. 1.1.2019 in respect of employees of Central Government and Central Autonomous Bodies continuing to draw their pay in the pre-revised pay scale/Grade Pay as per 6th Central Pay Commission.

2. The rate of DA admissible to above categories of employees of Central Government and Central Autonomous Bodies shall be enhanced from the existing 154% to 164% w.e.f. 01.07.2019
