**Note:**

In such a situation, announcement could be made through T.V. / A.I.R. / Newspaper and the heads of Department / Offices of the Central Govt. may take action according to such an announcement without waiting for a formal order, about the change of date.

No substitute holiday should be allowed if any of the festival holidays initially declared subsequently happens to fall on a weekly off or any other non-working day or in the event of more than one festival falling on the same days per para 3.2 of DoPT, Establishment (JCA) Section dated the 09<sup>th</sup> July, 2024.
