 the return on immovable property for the year 2022 (as on 31/12/2022), in the enclosed
 proforma.
- Immovable property return with phrases such as "same as last year" or "no change" will not be entertained.
- 4. The return should reach to the undersigned on or before 31/01/2023 failing which disciplinary action will be initiated against the government servant.
