Subject : **Grant of Ex-gratia payment to the West Bengal Govt. Pensioners/Family Pensioners for the year 2025.**

It is informed that the Government of West Bengal, Finance Department, in their Audit Branch Memo No. 1024-F(P₂) dated 18/3/2024 (copy enclosed) have sanctioned Ex-gratia Grant of ₹ 3,500/- (Rupees Three thousand and Five hundred only) in lump per head to all their pensioners including the holders of provisional pension who retired up to 30-09-2024 and also the pensioners who retired/died or will retire/die after 30-09-2024 but prior to 01-09-2025 and are not eligible to receive ad-hoc bonus.

2. The Ex-gratia grant sanctioned in the aforesaid Memo will also be admissible to the following categories of pensioners/family pensioners, as mentioned in Para 3 of the enclosed Memo.

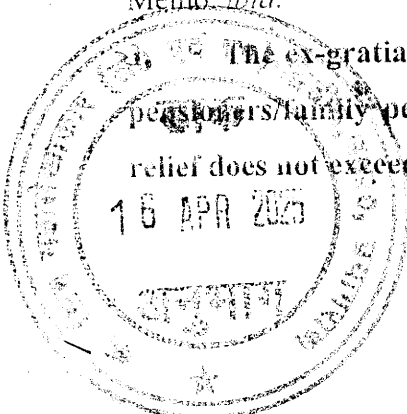
- (i) The holders of family pension, ex-gratia family pension and ad-hoc family pension;
- (ii) Pensioners (including widow pension holders) who draw their pension sanctioned under French Pension Rules;
- (iii) Holders of extra-ordinary pension; and
- (iv) Holders of ex-gratia pension

The classes of pensioner who will not come within the purview of the Memo have also been clearly indicated in Para 4 & 5 of the Memo *ibid*.

In this connection, it is informed that the **pro-rata pension holders** are also entitled to get the benefit of full amount of ex-gratia grant, sanctioned in the above Memo. in terms of Govt. of West Bengal, Finance Department, Pension Branch's clarificatory letter No. 805-F(Pen), dated 10-12-2008 (circulated by this Office circular No Pen. Co-ordn/7 Vol. III/64 Vol. II/191 dated 07-01-2009), subject to fulfillment of the conditions as laid down in the Memo *ibid*.

The ex-gratia grant sanctioned in the Memo. will, however, be admissible only to pensioners/family pensioners whose basic pension/family pension along with dearness relief does not exceed ₹ 38,000/- as on 31-03-2025.

4. The payment of ex-gratia as sanctioned in the Memo. should be made to the Muslim Pensioners/Family Pensioners before the festival of Id-UI-Fitre and to other than Muslim Pensioners/Family Pensioners, the payment in this regard may be made in between 15-9-2025 and 19-09-2025.


5. The charges on this account is debitable to the Govt. of West Bengal under the head "2071-Pension and other retirement benefits-01-Civil-800-Other Expenditure-NP-001-fund" required for meeting other expenditure-V-04-Pension/Gratuities" during the current financial year.

6. Necessary arrangements for payment of Ex-gratia @ ₹ 3,500/- (Rupees Three thousand and Five hundred only) to the eligible West Bengal Govt. pensioners/family pensioners may please be made, keeping in view the instructions contained in the enclosed Memo. as well as in this circular.

7. In this connection, it is also informed that for the teaching and non-teaching pensioners of the State aided Non-Govt. Educational Institution, non-Govt. colleges, separate circulars will be issued on receipt of the order from the respective Administrative Department as mentioned in last but one paragraph of the Memo *ibid*.

8. In case of any doubt/difficulty, the matter may be referred to this office for clarification.

MEMORANDUM

Subject: Grant of ex-gratia payment to the State Government Pensioners for the year 2024-2025.

The undersigned is directed by order of the Governor to say that in order to provide some relief to the State Government Pensioners during the ensuing festivals, the Governor has been pleased to decide that all State Government Pensioners including the holders of provisional pension who retired prior to 30.09.2024 and also the pensioners who retired or died after 30.09.2024 but prior to 01.09.2025 and whose basic pension plus Dearness Relief on pension as on 31st March, 2025 did not exceed Rs.38,000/- (Rupees Thirty eight thousand) only and are not eligible for ad-hoc bonus shall be paid an ex-gratia of Rs.3,500/- (Rupees Three thousand and five hundred) only in lump per head.

2. The charge is debitable to the head "2071-Pension and other retirement Benefits-01-Civil-800-other Expenditure-NP-001-fund required for meeting other expenditure-V-04-Pension/Gratuities" during the current financial year as well as 2025-26.

3. The ex-gratia grant sanctioned herein will also be admissible to:-

- i) The holders of family pension, ex-gratia family pension and ad-hoc family pension;
- ii) Pensioners (including widow pension holders) who draw their pension sanctioned under French Pension Rules;
- iii) Holders of extra-ordinary pension; and
- iv) Holders of ex-gratia pension.

The benefit will also be admissible to the pensioners of the undivided Government of Bengal and the pensioners of the erstwhile East Pakistan (now Bangladesh) Government who migrated to West Bengal and are receiving pension under "Provisional Payment of Pension Scheme".

4. The Ex-gratia grant sanctioned herein will not be admissible to the special categories of pensioners, such as:-

- i) Pensioners who have migrated from Pakistan;
- ii) Political Pensioners;
- iii) Special Pensioners;
- iv) War Risk Pensioners;
- v) Pensioners governed by the All India Services Rules.

5. The benefit will not be admissible to those who are entitled to ad-hoc bonus sanctioned by the State Government and those who are employed/re-employed under any Public Undertakings/Statutory Bodies under the Government and are in receipt of bonus or ex-gratia payment in lieu thereof during the current financial year.

6. State Government pensioners who draw their pension through Public Sector Banks will get this ex-gratia grant through their respective Bank Account. The Principal Accountant General(A&E), West Bengal will issue an authority for this purpose to all such Banks under the Kolkata Payment Scheme immediately on receipt of this order so that the pensioners may draw the ex-gratia grant immediately to make their commitments for their festival. The Treasury Office will take appropriate steps for issue of cheque to the

respective paying branches of the Banks and Post Offices, so that the pensioners receiving pension through Banks and Money Order get the payment of ex-gratia immediately to meet their commitments for their festival. No authority of the Principal Accountant General(A&E), West Bengal will be required for this purpose.

7. Subject to Para 6 above, this order will also be applicable to those who are eligible to this ex-gratia grant but whose pension/family pension has not yet been sanctioned. In their cases and in the case of persons who are drawing provisional pension, this amount of ex-gratia will be drawn by the authority competent to draw provisional pension in the same manner as the amount of provisional pension is drawn by him. In their cases, the facts of payment of ex-gratia grant should be intimated to the Principal Accountant General(A&E), West Bengal at the time of forwarding their pension papers for final sanction of pension.

The benefit of ex-gratia grant of **Rs.3,500/-** per head as has been sanctioned in this memorandum for the State Government Pensioners will also be allowed to the teaching and non-teaching Pensioners of State Aided Non-Government Educational Institutions and Pensioners of Panchayats, the Pensioners of Municipal Corporations/Municipalities/Local Bodies and other Organisations for whom Pension is authorized either by the Accountant General, West Bengal or the DPPG, West Bengal. In such cases the respective Administrative Department may sanction the benefit of ex-gratia payment @ **Rs.3,500/-** per head to the pensioners concerned under their control without making any further reference to Pension Branch of this Department.

The payment of ex-gratia as sanctioned hereinabove should be made before the festival of Id-UL-Fitre of 2025 for the Muslim Pensioners/Family Pensioners and other than Muslim Pensioners/Family Pensioners the benefits should be disbursed in between 15/09/2025 to 19/09/2025.



The Government of India, Ministry of Law and Justice, Department of Justice has appointed the Second National Judicial Pay Commission in pursuance of the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, vide Resolution 4th read above to examine and make suitable recommendations relating to the pay structure and emoluments of Judicial Officers in the States and Union Territories, including pension and other post-retirement benefits and also to examine the work methods and work environment with a view to promoting efficiency in judicial administration. The said Commission submitted its report on interim relief on 09.03.2018 and the Hon'ble Supreme Court by order dated 27.03.2018 directed all the States to implement the recommendations of the Commission with regard to interim relief. Accordingly, Government of Andhra Pradesh sanctioned 30% interim relief to all the Judicial Officers, Pensioners vide reference 6th read above.

2 The Second National Judicial Pay Commission has submitted its report with regard to the pay, pension and allowances of the Judicial Officers to Hon'ble Supreme Court of India. The Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, in their orders, dated 27.07.2022 in W.P.(C) No.643 of 2015 directed all the States/UTs to implement the revision of pay structure of Judicial Officers as recommended by SNJPC with effect from 01.01.2016.

3. The Government in pursuance of the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, dated 27.07.2022 and in obedience thereof hereby order to implement the revised pay scales to the Judicial Officers w.e.f.01.01.2016 as recommended by Second National Judicial Pay Commission as follows:

d. Fixation of pay in the pay matrix in regard to migration/fitment of the serving judicial officers on 01.01.2016 as indicated in Table-II above is broadly based on the following points:

- i. Multiply the existing pay by the factor of 2.81.
- ii. The figure so arrived at to be located in Table-I, in relation to the Level applicable to the Officer (i.e., J1, J2 etc.)
- iii. Where there is an identical figure available in Table-I at the corresponding stage of the relevant level, the new revised pay shall be fixed at that stage
- iv. Where there is no identical figure available, the new revised pay has to be fixed at the very next higher stage in that level in Table-I

e. Fixation of pay on promotion on or after 01.01.2016.

For those who are promoted from the previous level to the next level, or granted financial upgradation/ACP or Selection Grade or Super Time Scale, the procedure for fixing the pay in the new pay matrix on such promotion/financial upgradation, will be as follows:

- i. Identify the level and the basic pay in Table-I on the date of promotion.
- ii. Add one increment in that level itself in terms of FR-22.
- iii. The figure so arrived at or the next closest figure in the level to which s(he) is promoted will be the new pay on promotion.

f. Increment:

The annual increment shall be @ 3% cumulative meaning thereby that the increment @ 3% has to be calculated on the previous years basic pay instead of fixed amount increments recommended by FNJPC and JPC

g. Dearness Allowance & other Allowances

Dearness Allowance shall be as admissible at the rates applicable to the Central Government employees drawing VII CPC Pay Scales. As regards the other allowances, the amounts presently being drawn shall continue to be drawn pending further orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in that regard and subject to final adjustment.

h. Payment of Arrears:

The arrears shall be computed with effect from 01.01.2016 and after adjusting the interim relief already paid, the balance amount shall be paid in stages in the following manner, subject to production of an undertaking in the Form appended to this order:

2. It is informed that certain retired employees have filed various cases in the Hon'ble High Court, AP, seeking a direction to stop further recovery of commutation portion of pension from their original basic pension and to refund the excess amounts already recovered, as the entire commutation amount along with interest has been recovered before the stipulated 15-year period against Rule 18 of the Andhra Pradesh Civil Pensions (Commutation) Rules, 1944.

3. In this regard, vide reference 1st cited, the Learned Additional Advocate General has requested to file the counter Affidavit in cases mentioned in the reference 2nd cited and other connected Writ Petitions at the earliest preferably before the date fixed by the Hon'ble Division Bench i.e., on or before 29.11.2024. The Learned AAG

advised to instruct the concerned not to deduct the commutation amount from those pensioners who have completed 11 years 3 months from the date of sanction of commutation until the final orders of the Hon'ble Court, in view of the various cases that are being filed daily by the retired pensioners.

4. In view of the above circumstances, the Director of Treasuries & Accounts is hereby instructed **not to deduct the commutation portion of pension** from all the pensioners who have completed 11 years 3 months, till further orders.
