BACKGROUND

Disasters threaten the lives, constitutional rights and needs of the children worldwide. In past two decades India have faced devastating disasters such as Latur Earthquake (1993), Odisha Super Cyclone (1999), Bhuj Earthquake (2001), Indian Tsunami (2004), Jammu & Kashmir Earthquake (2005), Bihar Floods (2008), Uttarakhand Floods (2013), Cyclone Phailin (2013), Chennai Flood (2015), Kerala Flood (2018), Cyclone Fani (2019), Covid-19 (2020-21) and Assam Floods (2022) etc. It is estimated 535 million children, nearly one in four, live in conflict- or disaster-stricken countries, with restricted access to medical care, quality education, proper nutrition and protection. During 2000-2016: In five major natural disasters 17,671 children lost their lives, an equal number of children was injured and 19,466 schools were destroyed. During Covid 19 also the children were highly vulnerable.

Keeping in view the increasing vulnerability of children from climate change and natural disasters, National Institute of Disaster Management (NIDM), Ministry of Home Affairs, Government of India has established “**Child Centric Disaster Risk Reduction (CCDRR) Centre**”. The special focus of the Centre is on multi-hazard vulnerability/exposure and how to develop capacities of the stakeholders towards ZERO tolerance for Children at Risk. CCDRR Centre is supporting States in building their capacities by training their officials about Risk Informed Programming, Life Cycle Approach, School Safety, Mental Health Issues, Child Rights, Child Risk Impact Assessment, and developing their Policy Framework accordingly to mainstream Child Centric Disaster Risk Reduction.
