


Subject : Clarification on revision of Pension / Family Pension and extension of revised rates of Dearness Relief and other benefits in respect of Judicial Officers of the Government of West Bengal

Subsequent to issue of circular vide No. Pen. Co-ordn./65Vol-V/94 dated 27/09/2023 followed by Pen. Co-ordn./65 Vol.V/15 dated 29/04/2024 regarding the subject cited above, this office is in receipt of various communications from Pension Disbursing Authorities including Public Sector Banks disbursing Government pension in Kolkata Municipal Corporation Area, seeking certain clarification regarding modus operandi of revision of pension as per recommendation of Second National Judicial Pay Commission in respect of Officers of West Bengal Judicial Service / family pensioner of such category who retired / died in harness prior to 01/01/2006.

2. Therefore, with a view to facilitate Pension Disbursing Authorities for effecting such revision of pension following is stated -

(a) In case of pre-2006 pensioner having qualifying service of 33 years and above, pension per mensem drawn before 01/01/2006, as mentioned in certificate issued by the Judicial Department, Government of West Bengal to the Pension Disbursing Authority in accordance with their Memo No. 7014-J dated 25/10/2010, to be multiplied with factor of two. Amount thus arrived at to be considered as pay / notional last pay prior to 01/01/2006. Pension Disbursing Authority shall locate such notional last pay in column 2 of Annexure-I to this circular and find out the quantum of pay corresponding thereto from the Column No. 5 thereof. Such quantum of pay, thus arrived, if transposed to column 2 of Annexure-I of previous circular dated 27/09/2023 ibid, issued by this office in this regard, would reveal corresponding notional last pay as on 01/01/2016, as specified in Column 3, on which revised pension / revised family pension effective from 01/01/2016 to be calculated as

per Column 4 & 5 of the said annexure (Annexure-I of the previous circular dated 27/09/2023).

(b) If the qualifying service is less than 33 years, such cases to be forwarded to Judicial Department, Government of West Bengal for ascertaining quantum of last pay drawn prior to 01/01/2006.

(c) Cases, where pension of a pre-2006 retiree, Judicial-Officers cannot be revised by the Pension Disbursing Authority in absence of certificate issued from the Uudicial Department, i.e. Pension Sanctioning Authority for implementation of GO No. 7014-J dated 25/10/2010 or due to whatsoever reason, such cases are to be referred to the Judicial Department, Government of West Bengal under intimation to the pensioners concerned.

(d) For retired Judicial Officers of the Government of West Bengal or family pensioners of such category, drawing pension / family pension from other State, office of the concerned State Accountant General would facilitate revision of pension / family pension through Disbursing Authority of that State.

(e) Cases, where revised pension / family pension of pensioners / family pensioners drawing pension from other State cannot be ascertained, the same may be taken up with the Judicial Department, Government of West Bengal, routed through this office.

3. Pensioners / family pensioners are also entitled to dearness relief on their additional quantum of pension / family pension.

4. For the purpose of determination of age of family pensioner, when the date of birth is not available in Pension Payment Order, anyone of the under mentioned documents shall be accepted as proof of date of birth / age for payment of additional quantum of family pension on completion of age of 75 years. In case of different dates of birth in different certificates / documents mentioned below, the date of birth first recorded and accepted in the office of the Government of West Bengal for payment of family pension shall be final –

- (a) School final / Madhyamik or equivalent examination admit card / certificate.
- (b) Voter I Card (EPIC)
- (c) PAN Card
- (d) Aadhaar Card

5. The benefit of Domestic Help Allowance will be increased by 30% of the admissible rate as per the G.O. 1029-J on completion of five years from 01/01/2016 that is, w.e.f. 01/01/2021, regardless the date of retirement of the pensioners concerned as clarified by Government of West Bengal in their Judicial Department letter No. I/548251/2024-J JD/V/2A-12/24 dated 21/08/2024.

6. For Judicial Officers who retired / died-in-harness on or after 01-01-2016, revised authority for pension / family pension would be issued by the office of the Accountant General (A&E), West Bengal to all Pension Disbursing Authorities / office of the Accountants General (A&E) in other State. When a retired officer opts for additional commutation on account of revision of pension, such additional commutation will be restored after fifteen years from the date of superannuation of the Judicial Officer.


7. Information regarding payment of pension / family pension, revision of such pension, commutation and its restoration, payment of additional quantum of pension etc., as applicable for pre-2016 and post-2016 pensioners to be forwarded to the office of the Accountant General (A&E), West Bengal, as per format mentioned in Annexure-II and Annexure-III of this circular respectively in soft copies through e-mail edppcn-agae-wb@nic.in, on six monthly basis for maintaining record at this end.

8. All concerned Pension Disbursing Authorities, are therefore, requested to make necessary arrangements for payment of revised pension / family pension along with dearness relief at revised rates, revised fixed medical allowance and domestic help allowance as per guidelines mentioned above, after proper adjustment.

9. All other conditions with regard to revision of pension / family pension and other ancillary benefits under Second National Judicial Pay Commission, communicated vide this office circular dated 27/09/2023 followed by circular dated 29/04/2024 remain unchanged.



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
Sub : Grant of ex-gratia payment for the year 2023-2024 payable to the pensioner/family pensioners of the teaching and non teaching employees of Non-Govt. Educational Institution governed by DCRB' 81 scheme

It is informed that the Govt. of West Bengal, Higher Education Department, Budget Branch in their Memo no. 35-SE(B)/1M-12/2008 dated 15/03/2024 have sanctioned ex-gratia grant of Rs3200/- (Rupees three thousand two hundred) only in lump per head to all pensioners/family pensioners of the teaching and non teaching employees of Non Govt. Educational Institution guided under DCRB' 81 scheme (excluding DA Getting Schools and Sanskrit Tolls) including the holders of provisional pension who retired/died prior to 30.9.2023 and also the pensioners/family pensioners who retired or died after 30.09.2010 but prior to 1-9-2024 and are not eligible to receive ad-hoc bonus.

2. The above categories of pensioners/family pensioners whose basic pension/family pension plus relief on pension as on March 31, 2024 did not exceed Rs.35000/- (Rupees thirty five thousand) only are entitled to get this benefit.

3. All Pension Disbursing Officers are, therefore, requested to make necessary arrangement for payment of Ex-gratia grant of Rs.3200/- (Rupees three thousand two hundred) only in lump for the year 2024 to the above categories of pensioners/family pensioners subject to fulfillment of above conditions.

5. The charges are debitable to the head 2071-Pen and other retirement benefit-01-Civil 109-Pension to Employees of State Aided Educational Institutions, during the current financial year.



ORDER

Rule 90(7) of KSRs Part III provides that if son or daughter of a Government employee is suffering from disorder or disability of mind or physically crippled or disabled so as to render him or her unable to earn his living even after the age of 25 years, family pension shall be payable to such son or daughter for life subject to certain conditions. Government vide order read 1st above had prescribed a format of Medical Certificate for determining the eligibility of Family Pension for life to the Mentally/ Physically disabled children which was incorporated as Annexure III to Rule 90 Part III KSR.

2. As per letters read above the Accountant General sought clarification regarding sanctioning family pension to special categories coming under Rule 90(6) Part III KSR and the applicability of Medical certificate to disabled children. It was also informed that certain Sanctioning authorities instead of medical certificate appended as Annexure III to Rule 90(7) of KSR Part III, are producing permanent disability certificate issued by Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Government of India, Department of Empowerment of

persons with Disabilities. Hence Accountant General has requested to clarify whether such certificate may also be accepted for authorizing family pension in eligible cases and whether holder of above permanent disability certificate could be exempted from producing the Medical Certificate from Civil surgeons every three years.

3. Government have examined the matter in detail. UDID Card or Unique Disability Identity card has been introduced by Government of India with a view of creating a National Database for PwDs, and to issue a Unique Disability Identity Card to each person with disabilities. Considering the UDID card and Rule 24(1)(g) of The Right of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016, Government are pleased to order that family pension shall be sanctioned to physically disabled/ mentally challenged children without insisting Medical certificate prescribed as per G.O.(P)No.526/2003/Fin dated 09/10/2003 but based on the permanent UDID card if any produced to substantiate the disability subject to the following conditions:-

(i) Family pension shall be sanctioned to physically disabled/ mentally challenged children above 25 years, if they are suffering from congenital disorder and the name of the disabled child was included in any one of the following document

(a) Service Book/ e-service book.

(b) Form 5A prescribed in Rule 90(13) Part III KSR.

(c) Pension Payment Order/ e-Pension Payment Order of the pensioner.

(ii) Income limit prescribed vide order read 4th above for sanctioning family pension to Unmarried daughters above 25 years and Parents (Rs.60,000/- per annum) shall be made applicable for sanctioning family pension to physically disabled/mentally challenged children above 25 years.

(iii) For the continued payment of family pension such children entitled to the pension shall produce an annual certificate (in the form in Annexure II to Rule 90(6) of KSR Part III) from the Revenue Authority

along with Life Certificate at the treasury one year after the date of commencement of the family pension.

(iv) The family pension payable to such children shall be stopped if they start earning their livelihood or not furnishing Annual certificate (Annexure II) and Life Certificate.

(v) If the name of the disabled child was not included in the documents specified in (i) above, specific sanction from Government may be obtained before sanctioning family pension to such cases.

In the case of Temporary UDID Card holders, Medical Certificate as prescribed in Government Order read 1st above is mandatory for determining the eligibility of Family Pension. The above conditions are also applicable to them.

4. Necessary amendment to the Kerala Service Rules Part III will be issued separately.



1. In continuation to this Department's Office Memorandum No. Fin(Pen)A(3)-1/2021-Part-II-Loose dated 17-09-2022 and Office Memorandum No. Fin(Pen)A(3)-1/2021-Part-II dated 13-03-2024 on the subject cited above, the undersigned is directed to say that the Governor, Himachal Pradesh is pleased to order the payment of 50% of the balance arrears (i.e. 22.50% of remaining 45% pension/family pension arrears) to the pensioners and family pensioners who have attained the age of 75 years and above, in the month of August, 2024. Now, the cumulative arrears released so far after taking into account the present release, shall be 77.50 % of the total arrears in respect of pre-2016 pensioners and family pensioners who have attained the age of 75 years and above.

2. All the Pension Disbursing Authorities (PDA) will ensure that any extra amount of pension/family pension, if recoverable, shall be adjusted from the arrears of pension/family pension being paid to them and only the balance amount is released.





Subject: - Grant of Dearness Relief to Himachal Pradesh Government Pensioners/Family Pensioners.

1. In continuation of this department's O.M. No. Fin (Pen)B(10)-6/98-IV-Loose dated 04th March, 2024, the Undersigned is directed to say that the Governor, Himachal Pradesh is pleased to decide that dearness relief @ 4% due from 01.01.2023 to the Government pensioners/family pensioners including AIS pensioners/family pensioners shall be paid by enhancing the existing rate from 38% to 42% from 01.10.2024.
 2. The additional Dearness Relief shall be paid with the pension/family pension for the month of October, 2024. The decision on payment of arrears of dearness relief for the period 01.01.2023 to 30.09.2024 will be taken separately in due course of time.
 3. Payment of Dearness relief involving a fraction of a rupee shall be rounded off to the next higher rupee.
 4. Other provisions governing grant of dearness relief to pensioners, such as, regulation of dearness relief during employment/re-employment, regulation of dearness relief where more than one pension is drawn etc. will remain unchanged.
- As dearness relief will be at a uniform rate, it has been decided to dispense with the issue of enclosing ready reckoner alongwith the dearness relief orders. It will be the responsibility of the Pension Disbursing Authority (PDA), including the Nationalized Banks, etc. to calculate the quantum of dearness relief payable in each individual case.

6. The Accountant General, (A&E) H.P., Treasury Officers and authorized Public Sector Banks are requested to arrange the payment of Dearness Relief to pensioners on the basis of these orders.





Subject: Payment of arrears to pre-2016 pensioners/family pensioners on account of revision of pension/ family pension w.e.f. 01.01.2016.

1. In continuation to this Department's Office Memorandum No. Fin(Pen)A(3)-1/2021-Part-II-Loose dated 17-09-2022 and the Office Memoranda No.Fin(Pen)A(3)-1/2021-Part-II dated 13-03-2024 and 28-08-2024 on the subject cited above, the undersigned is directed to say that the Governor, Himachal Pradesh, is pleased to order that entire balance arrears @ 22.50% of the total pension/ family pension arrears shall be paid to the pensioners and family pensioners who have attained the age of 75 years and above, with the pension/family pension of October, 2024 payable on 28th October, 2024. Now, after issuance of these orders, the cumulative arrears paid to pensioners/family pensioners who have attained the age of 75 years and above, will be 100% of the total arrears. Hence, balance arrears of this category of pensioners/family pensioners would be Zero.
2. All the Pension Disbursing Authorities (PDA) including banks and all the Drawing and Disbursing Officers (DDO's) in the Govt. Departments will ensure that any extra amount of pension, family pension, gratuity and leave encashment, if recoverable, shall be adjusted from the arrears of pension/family pension being paid to them and only the balance amount is released.
3. It shall be the responsibility of the pension Disbursing Authorities including Public Sector Banks, Drawing and Disbursing Officers that arrears as detailed in para-1 above, are drawn and disbursed to the pensioners and family pensioners who have attained the age of 75 years and above, in the month of October, 2024.



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
