Subject: Increase of Dearness Relief from 40% to 44% to the Mizoram Government pensioners/ family pensioners with effect from 01.11.2025.

The undersigned is directed to convey sanction of the Governor of Mizoram for enhancing Dearness Relief @ 4% from the existing rate of 40% to 44% to the pensioners and family pensioners under the Government of Mizoram with effect from 01.11.2025.

2. The Enhanced Dearness Relief @4% shall be paid in cash to all pensioners/ family pensioners of Government of Mizoram who continue to draw pension/ family pension.

3. Payment of Dearness Relief involving a fraction of rupees shall be rounded off to the next higher rupee.


4. Payment of enhanced Dearness Relief should be made in Indian Rupee (INR).

5. The rate of Dearness Relief is to be enhanced by 2% from the rate of 44% with effect from 01.04.2026.
