OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject:- Dearness Allowance/Dearness Relief.

No.F(PR)-53/2017/27. - The undersigned is directed to refer to this Department's O.M. No.F (PR)-53/2017/24, dated 21st November, 2018 and to say that the Governor of Meghalaya is pleased to decide that the Dearness Allowance/Dearness Relief payable to all categories of State Government employees/pensioners and family pension holders shall be enhanced from the existing rate of 5% to 7% with effect from 1st January, 2019.

- These orders shall also apply to the members of the work-charged establishment and casual workers, other than Bungalow Peons, holding posts in the pay levels as admissible to the employees of corresponding categories under the regular establishment/services/ posts.
- 3. The Deamess Relief under these orders shall remain suspended if the pensioners/family pensioners are employed/re-employed under the State/Central Government or employed/re-employed/permanently absorbed in the State's or Central Government's Company, Corporation, Undertaking or Autonomous Body. It shall, however, be revived after the spell of such employment/re-employment.
- 4. The payment on account of Deamess Allowance/Deamess Relief involving fractions of 50 paise and above may be rounded off to the next higher rupee and the fraction of less than 50 paise may be ignored.
- 5. The payment on account of the Dearness Allowance/Deamess Relief sanctioned herein shall be debited to the respective heads of accounts from which the employees draw their salary and the pensioners/ family pension holders, their pension.
